EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In January 2026, Alkhidmat Europe supported 43 families with monthly financial aid totaling 295,000 EGP and hosted 40 vulnerable families (approximately 200 individuals) in secure apartments across Cairo. Education support reached 21 university students, 15 medical interns, and 33 dentistry students, with total training and housing costs amounting to over 688,000 EGP, ensuring uninterrupted academic progress. Orphans care benefited 100 children, including 10 orphan families accommodated in fully furnished apartments, and a large-scale celebration event with in-kind and cash gifts enhanced psychosocial wellbeing. Health interventions included the coordination and treatment of 4 critical medical cases, while 20 volunteers and 10 external engagement activities reinforced program delivery and strengthened partnerships with institutions such as Aghosh USA, Aghosh UK, and Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan.

Alkhidmat Europe's Gaza operations reached 83,390 beneficiaries in January, delivering life-saving assistance across northern, central, and southern governorates. 168,000 liters of safe drinking water were supplied to displacement shelters, benefitting 80,500 people, while 1,800 hot meals reached 4,600 individuals and 40 food parcels supported 240 households. The response also included visits to sponsored orphan families for follow-up and distribution of essential items. All activities were implemented under direct field supervision, ensuring quality, safety, and accountability despite challenging operational conditions, reinforcing Alkhidmat Europe's commitment to meeting urgent humanitarian needs and protecting the dignity of vulnerable communities.

Programs Progress Updates

1- Family Support Program

This program helps vulnerable families achieve stability through financial assistance, housing support, and livelihood opportunities.

Project	Updates
Permanent Support – Financial Aid	Monthly cash assistance is provided to eligible families through Egypt Post. In January, a total of 295,000 EGP was delivered to 43 deserving families.
Vulnerable Families Hosting	The housing support program assisted 40 families (200 individuals) living in host apartments across Cairo. As part of ongoing field monitoring, a visit was conducted to 10th of Ramadan City to follow up on the financial needs of hosted families and review the apartments allocated to marginalized households.
Food Assistance	A total of 5,600 Food parcels were sent to Gaza in addition to 3 trucks of tents, to be distributed inside the Gaza Strip.

2- *Orphans Care Program*

The orphans program ensures financial, emotional, and educational stability for children who have lost one or both parents.

Project	Updates
Orphans Sponsorship	A total of 100 orphans received monthly support of \$50 each, amounting to 255,300 EGP disbursed via Egypt Post. Post-distribution calls were made to confirm receipt and gather family feedback.
Orphans Housing	Ten orphan families have been accommodated in fully furnished apartments for one year, ensuring stability, dignity, and improved living conditions.
Orphans Celebration Activity	A celebration was held for orphans, hosting 100 orphaned children along with their families. The event included the distribution of in-kind and cash gifts, recreational games, a lively and supportive atmosphere, and a shared dinner.

3- *Learning Support Program*

Education remains a top priority for Alkhidmat Europe's mission to restore normalcy and opportunity to displaced families.

Project	Updates
Financial Support for Students	A total of 21 university students continued receiving support amounting to 249,000 EGP in January.
Hosting for Medical Students	A total of 15 medical students are residing in two rented apartments at a cost of 36,000 EGP enabling them to continue their internship requirements for graduation.
Dentistry Students	A group of 33 dentistry students began their internships, supported with 403,000 EGP in training-related expenses. A dedicated meeting was held with the students at the office to follow up on their academic progress and professional challenges.

4- *Health Care Program*

The Health Care Program continued to support vulnerable families through medical referrals and treatment coordination. During January, **four** medical cases were admitted to Resala Hospital for specialized care. Ongoing coordination ensured access to medications, chronic illness follow-up, and emergency medical support for eligible patients.

5- *Gaza Relief Program*

Throughout January, Alkhidmat Europe sustained its humanitarian response across the central, southern, and northern Gaza Strip, focusing on life-saving assistance for displaced families. All activities were implemented under direct field supervision to ensure quality, safety, and dignified access.

- **Safe Drinking Water:** A total of 168,000 liters of safe drinking water were supplied to displacement shelters, benefiting 80,500 displaced persons, contributing to improved health conditions within the camps and strengthening the team's capacity to respond to essential needs in newly established displacement areas.
- **Food Security Activities:**
 - **Food Parcel:** A total of 40 food parcels were prepared and distributed across multiple governorates, benefiting 240 individuals.
 - **Hot Meals:** 1,800 hot meals were distributed across several shelters, reaching 4,600 individuals.
- **Orphan Family Visits – Southern Area:** A visit was conducted to an orphan family sponsored under the Health Care Worker program in Khan Younis. The family's situation was assessed, and a fruit parcel was provided to offer humanitarian support, meet part of their basic needs, and strengthen follow-up with sponsored families.

Internal and External Activities

Internal Meetings

Regular team meetings are held to review project progress, plan upcoming activities, and assess new social cases for inclusion in the Family Support Program.

While in Gaza, weekly coordination meetings were conducted via Google Meet, focusing on staff safety, implementation progress, upcoming plans, media documentation, and timely reporting to ensure accountability and effectiveness.

External Activities, Cairo Office

During January, a delegation of (10) guests representing Aghosh USA, Aghosh UK, Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan, and Alkhidmat Europe, during the period of 22–26 January 2026 and subsequent follow-up activities.

- The program began on Thursday, 22 January, with visits to the Palestinian Hospital in Cairo, Alkhidmat office in Cairo, and a meeting with Gazan medical students studying in South Africa.
- On Friday, 23 January, the day included an internal coordination meeting among Aghosh USA, Aghosh UK, AKFP, and AKE, followed by participation in food box packing at the Resala warehouse and a large community event for Palestinian families, including gift distribution for children.
- Saturday, 24 January, featured an internal meeting in Rehab, a visit to Taabu, a visit to 10th of Ramadan at the Alkhidmat apartments, and a dinner with Resala Charity Association.
- On 27 January, the delegation visited 10th of Ramadan City to renew the four-orphans building through a new contract and held meetings with owners of 17 apartments to agree on renewal terms, attended by Cairo Staff and Mahmoud Alshareef.
- This was followed on 28 January by a second visit to 10th of Ramadan City to renew and sign contracts for the 17-apartment building, with Cairo office staff.
- The visit concluded on 31 January with the distribution of financial assistance and gifts at Taabu community healing center.

Coordination, Partnerships, and Oversight

Strong governance and partnerships remained central to January's achievements. Regular internal coordination meetings were held in Cairo and Gaza, complemented by high-level external engagements. A multi-country delegation from Aghosh USA, Aghosh UK, Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan, and Alkhidmat Europe conducted site visits, renewed housing contracts, supported community events, and reinforced long-term collaboration frameworks.

Looking Ahead

January 2026 demonstrated Alkhidmat Europe's capacity to operate across borders with efficiency, transparency, and compassion. The organization remains committed to scaling impact, strengthening partnerships, and responding flexibly to evolving humanitarian needs, while continuing to place dignity, accountability, and sustainability at the center of its mission.
