Programs Progress Updates

1- Family Support Program

This program helps vulnerable families achieve stability through financial assistance, housing support, and livelihood opportunities.

- **Permanent Support – Financial Aid**
Monthly cash assistance continues to be provided to eligible families. In February, a total of EGP 40,000 was distributed to 4 vulnerable families.
- **Vulnerable Families Hosting**
The housing support program assisted 31 families (156 individuals) residing in host apartments across Cairo.
Two monitoring visits were conducted to follow up on living conditions and address operational challenges.
- **Seasonal Support – Food Parcel Distribution**
In partnership with a local organization, food parcels were distributed to 42 families (210 beneficiaries) in 10th of Ramadan City, with the support of 10 volunteers.

2- Orphans Care Program

The orphans program ensures financial, emotional, and educational stability for children who have lost one or both parents.

- **Orphans Sponsorship**
A total of 88 orphans received monthly financial support of USD 50 each, amounting to EGP 255,200, disbursed through Egypt Post. Post-distribution follow-up calls were conducted to confirm receipt and collect feedback from families.
- **Orphans Housing**
10 orphan families were accommodated in fully furnished apartments for one year, ensuring safe, stable, and dignified living conditions.

3- Learning Support Program

Education remains a top priority for Alkhidmat Europe opportunity to displaced families.

- **Financial Support for Students**
3 university students received continued financial support totaling EGP 24,000 in February.
- **Hosting for Medical Students**
15 medical students are currently accommodated in two rented apartments at a total cost of EGP 54,000, enabling them to complete their internship requirements.
- **Dentistry Students Support**
35 dentistry students began their internships, supported with EGP 410,000 covering training-related expenses. A dedicated follow-up meeting was held to monitor their academic progress and address professional challenges.
- **Alkhidmat School – Meraj**
The school serves 250 displaced Palestinian students (Grades 1-11) and employs 40 Palestinian teachers, with total staff expenses of EGP 492,400. A monitoring visit was conducted to assess operations under the Pyramids of Hope

Initiative, led by Ms. Maroua Abu Duqqa. A group Iftar was also organized for students and staff, creating a joyful and supportive environment.

- **Alkhidmat School – Alexandria**

This is the only operational school serving displaced Gaza students in Alexandria. It employs 30 teachers, with total monthly expenses of EGP 270,000, including salaries and rent.

Internal and External Meetings

Internal Meetings

- Online meeting with Mr. Qasim, (IT Engineer of Alkhidamt Europe) to follow up the website issues and orphans project updates.
- Two Online meeting with Mr. Irfan were held to review project progress, plan upcoming activities, coordinate projects and ensure alignment.
- Online meeting with Dr. Hamid for the financial aid payments, to ensure that families get the assistance in the time.
- In-person meeting with Mr. Irfan to follow up the project updates.

Guests Reception

World Care Foundation

- A delegation of 24 members participated in Alkhidmat Europe activities during March
- Visited 38 families in 10th of Ramadan City and distributed Eid packages (toys and cash gifts).
- Visited Alkhidmat School in Meraj.
- Organized a group Iftar for 39 Palestinian families, distributing Eid gifts and bringing joy to children.

Prof. Dr. Hafeez ur Rahman, Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan

- First day of Eid: Visited 42 families in 10th of Ramadan City and distributed Eid gifts to children.
- Second day of Eid: Participated in an Orphans Carnival in Obour City for 88 orphans and their families.

Gaza Strip – Programs Progress Update

During the reporting period, Alkhidmat Europe implemented a comprehensive humanitarian response across the Gaza Strip, focusing on food security, water provision, and social support for displaced and vulnerable populations. These interventions were carried out across the northern, central, and southern areas, ensuring broad and equitable reach.

Food Security Interventions

Iftar Meal Distribution

- Total meals distributed: 22,000 meals
- Total beneficiaries: 22,000 individuals
- Geographical coverage: Central, Southern, and Northern Gaza
- **Notes:** Daily large-scale distribution throughout Ramadan across multiple displacement camps, ensuring access to nutritious meals.

Suhoor Food Parcels

- Total parcels distributed: 1,500 parcels
- 1,250 parcels for Quran teachers and students
- 250 parcels for vulnerable families
- Estimated beneficiaries: 500+ households/individuals
- Notes: Targeted support for both educational communities and vulnerable families.

Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH)

Drinking Water Distribution

- Total water supplied: 63,000 liters
- Estimated beneficiaries: 19,000+ individuals
- Coverage: Primarily Northern Gaza
- Notes: Critical intervention to improve health and hygiene conditions in displacement shelters.

Social Protection and Seasonal Support

Eid Clothing Distribution

- Total children supported: 500 orphaned children
- Modality: Clothing vouchers (USD 50 per child)
- Notes: Implemented over two days, allowing children to choose their own Eid outfits, promoting dignity and joy.

Zakat Al-Fitr Distribution

- Total parcels distributed: 1,200 parcels
- Total beneficiaries: 6,000 individuals
- Notes: Timely assistance to vulnerable families ahead of Eid, helping ease financial burdens.

Community Iftar Event

- Total beneficiaries: 500 individuals
- Notes: Brought together vulnerable families and orphans in a shared meal, strengthening social cohesion and providing psychosocial relief.
- Orphans Annual Celebration
- Total children reached: 150 orphaned children (over two days)
- Activities included: Financial support, Suhoor parcels, Iftar meals, and recreational activities
- Notes: Combined material assistance with psychosocial support, enhancing well-being and inclusion.

Individual Case Support

- Total cases: 1 case
- Notes: Home visit conducted for a sick orphan unable to attend activities, ensuring inclusion and emotional support.

Team Coordination Meetings

Weekly coordination to monitor implementation, ensure staff safety, and improve program delivery.





Uganda



Ramadan Efforts in Uganda

During Ramadan 2026, Alkhidmat Europe, in partnership with Alkhidmat Uganda, implemented a food distribution program targeting vulnerable communities in Buwenge, Bugembe, Butangala, Butiki, and Lwanda, reaching over 200 families.

Each family received a food package including rice, sugar, cooking oil, and salt, ensuring access to essential nutrition throughout the holy month.

The program was delivered in coordination with local leaders, ensuring transparent targeting and dignified distribution.

Impact:

- Reduced food insecurity among vulnerable families
- Enabled beneficiaries to observe Ramadan and celebrate Eid with dignity
- Strengthened community solidarity

Challenges & Lessons:

Logistical constraints in remote areas highlighted the need for stronger partnerships and improved access for future interventions.



Pakistan



Our efforts in Pakistan

During March, Alkhidmat Europe implemented a range of humanitarian and development programs across multiple regions in Pakistan, reaching a total of 2,650 beneficiaries with a combined investment of PKR 8,660,000.

Key Interventions:

- **Food Assistance:** Distributed 200 food packs benefiting 800 individuals, supporting vulnerable families including refugees in AJK and communities in Lahore.
- **Ramadan Support (Suhor/Iftar):** Provided 1,000 meals to individuals in Chitral and Islamabad, ensuring food security during the holy month.
- **WASH Services:** Implemented 2 WASH interventions, reaching 550 beneficiaries in underserved areas, improving access to clean water and sanitation.
- **Zakat Ul Fitr Distribution:** Supported 100 vulnerable individuals, including orphans in South Punjab and KPK (Gujrat & Kharian).
- **Education & Skills Development:**
 - Bano Qabil Program: Benefited 100 participants, focusing on youth empowerment.
 - Skill Training Center: Supported 100 individuals in Gujrat and Kharian, enhancing livelihood opportunities.

Geographic Coverage:

Activities were implemented across AJK, Lahore, Chitral, Islamabad, South Punjab, KPK, Gujrat, and Kharian, targeting refugees, orphans, and vulnerable communities.
