Programs Progress Updates

1- Family Support Program

This program helps vulnerable families achieve stability through financial assistance, housing support, and livelihood opportunities.

- **Permanent Support – Financial Aid**

Monthly cash assistance continues to be provided to eligible families. In April, a total of **750 USD** was distributed to **4** vulnerable families.

- **Vulnerable Families Hosting**

The housing support program assisted **31** families (**156** individuals) residing in host apartments across Cairo.

On April 10th, a guest from the United States of America was received, and families in the 10 of Ramadan housing were visited and a small celebration was held for them.

- Seasonal Support:

- Packing 5 trucks of parcels and meat, and one truck of meat only
- Loading five trucks of parcels and one truck of meat
- Sending 57,600 cans of meat to Gaza

2- Orphans Care Program

The orphans program ensures financial, emotional, and educational stability for children who have lost one or both parents.

- **Orphans Sponsorship**

A total of **88** orphans received monthly financial support of **USD 50** each, amounting to **4,200 USD**, disbursed through Egypt Post. Post-distribution follow-up calls were conducted to confirm receipt and collect feedback from families.

- **Orphans Housing**

10 orphan families were accommodated in fully furnished apartments for one year, ensuring safe, stable, and dignified living conditions.

3- Learning Support Program

Education remains a top priority for Alkhidmat Europe's mission to restore normalcy and opportunity to displaced families.

- **Financial Support for Students**

6 university students received continued financial support totaling **1,150 USD** in April.

- **Hosting for Medical Students**

15 medical students are currently accommodated in two rented apartments at a total cost of **1,000 USD**, enabling them to complete their internship requirements.

- **Dentistry Students Support**

34 dentistry students began their internships, supported with **7,500 USD** covering training-related expenses. A dedicated follow-up meeting was held to monitor their academic progress and address professional challenges.

- **Alkhidmat School – Meraj**

The school serves **250** displaced Palestinian students (Grades 1–11) and employs **40** Palestinian teachers, with total staff expenses of **7,500 USD**. A monitoring visit was conducted to assess operations under the Pyramids of Hope

Initiative, led by Ms. Maroua Abu Duqqa.

On April 8th, the school was visited and a ceremony was held to honor outstanding students.

- **Alkhidmat School – Alexandria**

This is the only operational school serving displaced Gaza students in Alexandria. It employs **30** teachers for 150 students, with total monthly expenses of **5,000 USD**, including salaries and rent.

Gaza Strip – Programs Progress Update

During the reporting period, Alkhidmat Europe implemented a comprehensive humanitarian response across the Gaza Strip, focusing on food security, water provision, and social support for displaced and vulnerable populations. These interventions were carried out across the northern, central, and southern areas, ensuring broad and equitable reach.

Food Security Interventions

Meal Distribution

- Total meals distributed: 11,500 meals
- Total beneficiaries: 11,500 individuals
- Geographical coverage: Central, Southern, and Northern Gaza

Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH)


Drinking Water Distribution

- Total water supplied: 205,400 liters
- Estimated beneficiaries: 89,000+ individuals
- Coverage: Primarily Northern Gaza
- Notes: Critical intervention to improve health and hygiene conditions in displacement shelters.

Orphans Program

- Efforts are ongoing to communicate with the families of 1,708 orphans to complete the necessary procedures and facilitate the transfer of financial sponsorships. This ensures that support reaches eligible beneficiaries in a transparent and timely manner.





Uganda



Summary

April 2026 was a productive and operationally intensive month for Alkhidmat Uganda. Activities focused on strengthening academic monitoring systems, improving data management, and preparing for upcoming program milestones. Key areas of work included data management, end-of-term reporting, student attendance tracking, examinations, and preparations for the upcoming Qurbani program.

Key Activities:

- **Students Program:**

- 1- Data Entry and System Management: To ensure that records remain accurate, up-to-date, and reliable, supporting effective tracking, informed decision-making, and organizational transparency.
- 2- End-of-Term Reporting: To prepare end-of-term report cards and upload them to the portal, enhancing transparency and accountability, reflecting students' academic progress, and strengthening donor engagement by highlighting achievements and areas for improvement.
- 3- Student Attendance Monitoring (Roll Call): To track attendance, support students, and link attendance to academic performance.
- 4- Examinations: To assess students' academic progress, link support to performance, and motivate students.

- **East Africa Educational and Training Visit:**

- Alkhidmat Uganda, under the leadership of Mr. Abbas Khurram, hosted a Pakistani educational delegation as part of an East Africa tour covering Uganda, Kenya, and Rwanda.
- The visit included meetings and institutional tours, notably at Bugembe Islamic Institute (Primary and Secondary Sections), with a focus on education, training, technology, and Dawah.
- Delegation Members: Molana Habib Ahmed Hanfi, Mr. Najeeb Ahmed Hanfi and Mr. Jalal Ahmed Khan.
- The visit aimed to strengthen international collaboration and explore new partnerships and opportunities across the region.

- **Qurbani Preparations:**

- The initiative aims to support vulnerable families by fulfilling a key religious obligation for those unable to afford it.
- Planning activities are progressing to ensure effective and timely implementation.

Pakistan



Our efforts in Pakistan

Alkhidmat Europe continues to implement targeted humanitarian and development interventions across Pakistan, focusing on child welfare, access to safe water, and community-based services. Key achievements and ongoing initiatives are outlined below:

Key Interventions:

- **Orphan Family Support Program (OFSP).**

Alkhidmat Europe currently sponsors 290 orphaned children across Pakistan under the OFSP. The program provides sustained financial assistance to orphan families, coupled with structured follow-up through dedicated welfare officers who conduct quarterly monitoring visits. This ensures accountability, tracks child wellbeing, and supports continued access to education, nutrition, and basic services.

- **Water Supply and Infrastructure Projects**

To address water scarcity and improve public health outcomes in underserved rural communities, the following interventions have been implemented:

- ✚ **01 Submersible Water Pump (under installation):**

Designed to access deep underground water sources, this system will provide a reliable and safe water supply, contributing to reduced incidence of waterborne diseases and improved agricultural use.

Location: Village Bathan, UC Oach, Tehsil Adinzay, District Dir Lower, KPK-Pakistan

Pump Depth: 150-200 ft

Households Served: 100+ Families

Estimated Daily Beneficiaries: (approx. 350+ Individuals)

- ✚ **01 Community Hand Pump (installed):**

Strategically located to serve an entire neighborhood, this intervention ensures equitable access to clean water through a low-maintenance, electricity-independent system.

Location: Sindh, Pakistan

Pump Depth: 125-175 ft

Households Served: 70+ Families

Estimated Daily Beneficiaries: (approx. 250+ Individuals)

- ✚ **02 Small Hand Pumps (installed):**

- Pump 1 — South Punjab-Pakistan Village Basti Goli Wala, UC Taleri, Tehsil/District Muzaffargarh Beneficiaries: 130+ Individuals
- Pump 2 — South Punjab-Pakistan Village Kho Goji Wala, UC Sheikh Omar Tehsil/District Kot Addu Beneficiaries: 140+ Individuals

These installations collectively benefit **270+ individuals**, improving daily access to safe drinking water at the household level.

- **Community Development and Child Protection Services**

Alkhidmat Europe supports the Child Protection Center (CPC) in Azam Garden, Lahore, a multi-service facility delivering educational support, healthcare services,

and skills development programs. The center serves as a critical community hub for hundreds of vulnerable families, strengthening local resilience and social protection mechanisms.
