



HEALTH INFO

Parents will be notified immediately to pick up any camper who develops a fever or shows signs of being ill. For more information and our guidelines for returning to camp, please review our parent handbook online.

- A child with a fever or illness symptoms must be fever and symptom-free for 24 hours (without the aid of fever reducer). This includes vomiting or diarrhea.

DRESS CODE

- Closed-toe shoes are required for outdoor play
- One-piece swimsuits are required for girls. If a two-piece is worn, a T-shirt must be worn over it.
- Shorts and skirts must cover half of the top of the leg.
- Spaghetti strap tank tops, halter tops, tube tops, and mid-riff shirts are not allowed.
