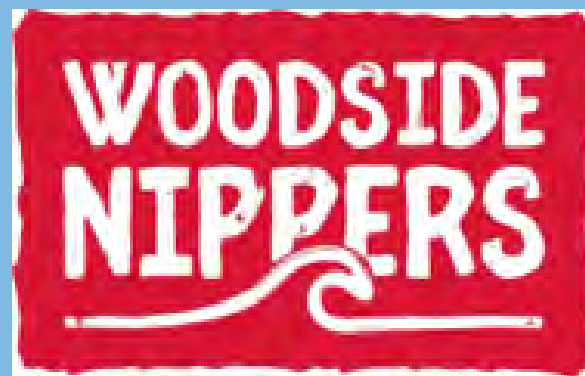




SCARBORO WOODSIDE NIPPER INFORMATION PACK



Welcome to Scarborough Surf Life Saving Club

Founded in 1928, Scarborough SLSC is located on the Esplanade in Scarborough, within the City of Stirling. Scarborough Beach is located approximately 14kms from Perth CBD and is well served through high-frequency public transport making it easily accessible to the greater Perth metropolitan area.

At Scarborough SLSC our Club's purpose is to cultivate and develop an active and healthy community to generate better and more resilient people through surf lifesaving. We are affiliated with Surf Life Saving WA and Surf Life Saving Australia.

In 2028, we will mark our 100th anniversary and are excited about the seasons ahead as we approach that milestone now that we are settled into our new purpose-built facilities as part of the Scarborough Foreshore Redevelopment.

- *Age Group U6 to U7: **Wednesday 9/12/2026**, Time: 4:30pm to 6:30pm.*

Collection will be available at 0800 on the first two Sundays of nippers, of October 2026 for U8 to U13 and January 2027 for U6 & U7.

Woodside Nipper Age Group Categories

Woodside Nippers are placed in an age group that is determined by the child's age as at 30 September each year. The education program for each age group works towards the Surf Life Saving Australia (SLSA), Age Group Certificate listed below. To easily identify our Woodside Nipper age groups, we have different cap colours.



The SLSA age groups do not align with the school year cohorts so from time-to-time school friends may be in the group above or below. We are unable to accommodate requests to change age groups to be with friends for Sunday Morning activities. We are required to comply with the policies set by SLSA. This is a good opportunity for children to connect with new friends and develop themselves within the Surf Life Saving movement. There is weekly training, social and other activities offered in which children will be able to socialise and participate with their friends across the age groups.

Preliminary Swimming Evaluations

Preliminary Evaluations are a risk management procedure to appraise the swimming capabilities of participants and must be done as part of club's duty of care. Preliminary Evaluations must be conducted before Woodside Nippers participate in any water-based activities at your club. These evaluations can be completed either in a swimming pool or in open water.

U6	Back or front float for min 5 seconds, recover to stand.	Submerge to touch the bottom with hands. (1m depth)	From standing position in waist deep water, perform a front glide (1-2 metres) & recover to stand.
U7	Back or front float for minimum of 10 seconds, recover to stand.		From standing position in waist deep water, perform a front glide (2-3 metres) & recover to stand.
U8	Back or front float for min 15 seconds, recover to stand.		Swim on front any stroke (distance 20 metres) followed by swim underwater (distance 2-3 metres).
U9	Front to back float or back to front float – 5 seconds each side. Tread water and/or any stroke sculling for a minimum of 1 minute.	Submerge to touch the bottom with hands. (1.5m depth)	Swim on front through water any stroke for 25 metres followed by survival stroke(s) breaststroke and/or sidestroke and/or back sculling for minimum 10 metres
U10			Swim on front through water any stroke for 25 metres followed by survival stroke(s) breaststroke and/or sidestroke and/or back sculling for minimum 25 metres
U11	Front to back float or back to front float – 5 seconds each side. Tread water and/or any stroke sculling for a minimum of 2 minute.	Submerge to perform forward or backward roll/somersault underwater, recover to surface, submerge to touch the bottom with hands. (1.5m depth)	Swim on front through water any stroke for 25 metres followed by survival stroke(s) breaststroke and/or sidestroke and/or back sculling for minimum 50 metres.
U12	Front to back float or back to front float – 5 seconds each side. Tread water and/or any stroke sculling for minimum 3 minutes.	Submerge to perform forward or backward roll/somersault underwater, recover to surface, submerge to touch the bottom with hands (1.8m)	Swim on front any stroke for 75 metres followed by survival stroke(s) breaststroke and/or sidestroke for minimum 50 metres
U13			Swim on front any stroke for 100 metres followed by survival stroke(s) breaststroke and/or sidestroke for minimum 50 metres

Competition Carnival Evaluations

To maintain safety and lifesaving standards, SLSA has set a minimum standard of proficiency that Nipper Activities Members (Woodside Nippers) must achieve before being eligible to compete in water events at carnivals (see table below).

Age Group	Competition Evaluation
U8	Minimum 100m open water swim in 6 minutes
U9	Minimum 100m open water swim in 6 minutes
U10	Minimum 150m open water swim in less than 8 minutes
U11	Minimum 200m open water swim in less than 8 minutes
U12	Minimum 200m open water swim in less than 8 minutes
U13	Minimum 200m open water swim in less than 7 minutes



Sunday Morning Activities

The Woodside Nipper club activities occur on Sunday mornings.

The sessions commence at 0900 hours.

- U6 and U7 expect to finish between 1000 and 1030hrs
- U8 to U13 expect to finish between 1030 and 1100hrs.

Finish times are dependent on conditions on the day.

Where do I take my Woodside Nipper on Sundays?

- Assemble on the beach near your cap-coloured flag, at least 5 minutes before the start time above with your cap and fluoro vest on, ready for activities
- Ensure your child already has sunscreen applied
- Age Group Managers will call a roll and mark off an attendance sheet
- Woodside Nippers will rotate through activities (water, beach, games, education).
- Woodside Nippers must always stay with their Age Group Manager, unless coaches take over for a specific activity
- If Woodside Nippers must leave their group (e.g., to go to the toilet etc.), the Age Group Manager must be informed prior to them leaving and they should be accompanied by a parent/guardian
- No Woodside Nipper is to enter the water unless authorised by the Age Group Manager
- U6s & U7s must have a parent/guardian always remain with the age group
- All Woodside Nippers must have a parent/ guardian on the beach/surrounds throughout the session and be on hand to assist your child in the event of an incident or injury
- At the conclusion of the session, Woodside Nippers are again checked off the attendance roll after all equipment and boards have been packed away onto the trailers
- Woodside Nippers are not to leave the group until collected by an adult and checked off the attendance roll. Failure to sign your child out may result in the closure of the beach and a search being carried out to find them
- Club caps are to be removed at the end of the session once Woodside Nippers have been checked off the attendance roll
- Once Woodside Nippers have been checked off the attendance roll and removed their Club caps, any Woodside Nippers re-entering the water are the responsibility of their parents/guardians
- By requirement of SLSWA, all Woodside Nippers must wear the supplied fluoro, hi-viz lycra vest during water activities at all sanctioned Club activities, including Club days, training sessions and competitions.

Member Protection

Scarboro SLSC supports its service delivery with a Member Protection Policy and Club Code of Conduct that is overseen by our Club's Member Protection Information Officer (MPIO). The MPIO provides information and guidance on such things as working with children requirements, national police clearances, and complaints procedures. The MPIO is the 'go to' person if you want to discuss problems or grievances at our Club, particularly if you are considering making a formal complaint. The MPIO will work with you to present any grievance or complaint to the Club's Complaints Manager, who will oversee the complaint.

Training Opportunities

Training is available outside of normal Sunday activities to all nippers in a variety of surf life saving disciplines including board paddling, surf swimming and beach events. All training sessions are designed to cater for all skill levels.

Please Note: Parents and caregivers are required to bring their children to the coaches, this is not a drop and run sport as it comes with high risks being by the water. Each child must have a parent or nominated adult on the beach or the applicable venue during activities for safety or the child will be unable to participate.

Education for Parents/Guardians

Belong to something bigger. Your membership at Scarborough SLSC is about more than just learning safe on our beaches, it's about helping to protect the community while becoming a part of one.

A key award for all parent / guardians in the Woodside Nipper program requires parents to complete the 'Nipper Rescue Certificate'. A short course that enables you as the parent / guardian to support the delivery on the beach. We can't do it without you.

The Nipper Rescue Certificate helps parents become more confident and familiar with conditions, assisting children in the water, carnival water safety and helping with a rescue (if needed). Please visit our [Team App](#) for course dates and how to register.

Requirements: Recognise safe beach zones 200m Ocean Swim
Demonstrate Aquatic Rescue with a Rescue Tube and a contact tow
Learn the Signals: – Assistance required – Attract attention – Remain stationary – Go to the right and left – Return to shore – Proceed further out to sea – Pick up swimmer

Volunteers

All Age Group Managers, officers, nipper crew and coaches are volunteers. We encourage and are seeking more assistance. Please consider joining and assisting with the nipper program at Scarborough. Training opportunities and support is available.

Officials to Support Your Child in Competition

Each club is required to provide officials so that each child can compete. The officials help with the running of the carnivals either by judging, marshalling competitors, presenting medals, recording results or starting races.

Club BBQ and Canteen

Each age group will be allocated a week to oversee the delivery and support the canteen each Sunday. Your age manager will communicate and have available a copy of the roster on Team App.

The weekend process typically includes:

- Meet at the canteen at 9.00am.
- Collect the marquee and barbeque from the gear shed.
- Set up to be completed by 9.15am normally on the limestone section in front of the Gym.
- The BBQ box, sausages, onions, bread and sauces will be supplied.
- Sausage sizzle joining instructions will be emailed to you prior to your rostered duty.

All Abilities Program

Is an inclusive program providing children with special needs the opportunity to participate in Surf Lifesaving.

The All Abilities Standalone Program running from January to March at the Scarborough Surf Life Saving Club provides children with special needs the opportunity to participate in a specialised water safety program alongside a parent or guardian that is accommodating to their needs, having the opportunity to experience the beach and all that Surf Life Saving has to offer.

Competition Opportunities

Whether you're new to carnivals or experienced these events are a fantastic opportunity to have fun, meet other avid beach goers and network to your hearts content. Either way we are here to help give every nipper and parent the opportunity to enjoy the experience.

Who can compete?

- U8-U13s who have completed their competition evaluation
- Nipper carnivals are divided into “Little Nipper” U8-9 carnivals and “Nipper” U10-13 inter club carnivals

Nipper Carnivals

Supporting the growth and development of our Nippers Surf Life Saving WA offer a range of carnival competitions for your Nipper. For more information your Age Manager will guide you on the registration process and fees.

Competition is designed to provide an environment to enhance the lifesaving skills used for patrols. The Club runs a program that encourages every member to achieve their own competition goals. Our coaching programs are designed to support our children in all aspects of competition by practicing the skills they learn in groups on Club days suitable to their ability. Not all children want to be involved in competition and there are pathways the Club provides in life saving and other activities. There are a range of carnivals that members can enter throughout the year. Please refer to the Club website and Club emails for more details as they become available.

Surf Life Saving WA publish up to date carnival schedules and a comprehensive competition guide on their website. Nippers in the U8-U13 age groups who wish to compete at the State Championships must have achieved their respective age award, passed the competition proficiency swim and competed in at least one SLSWA Nipper Carnival.

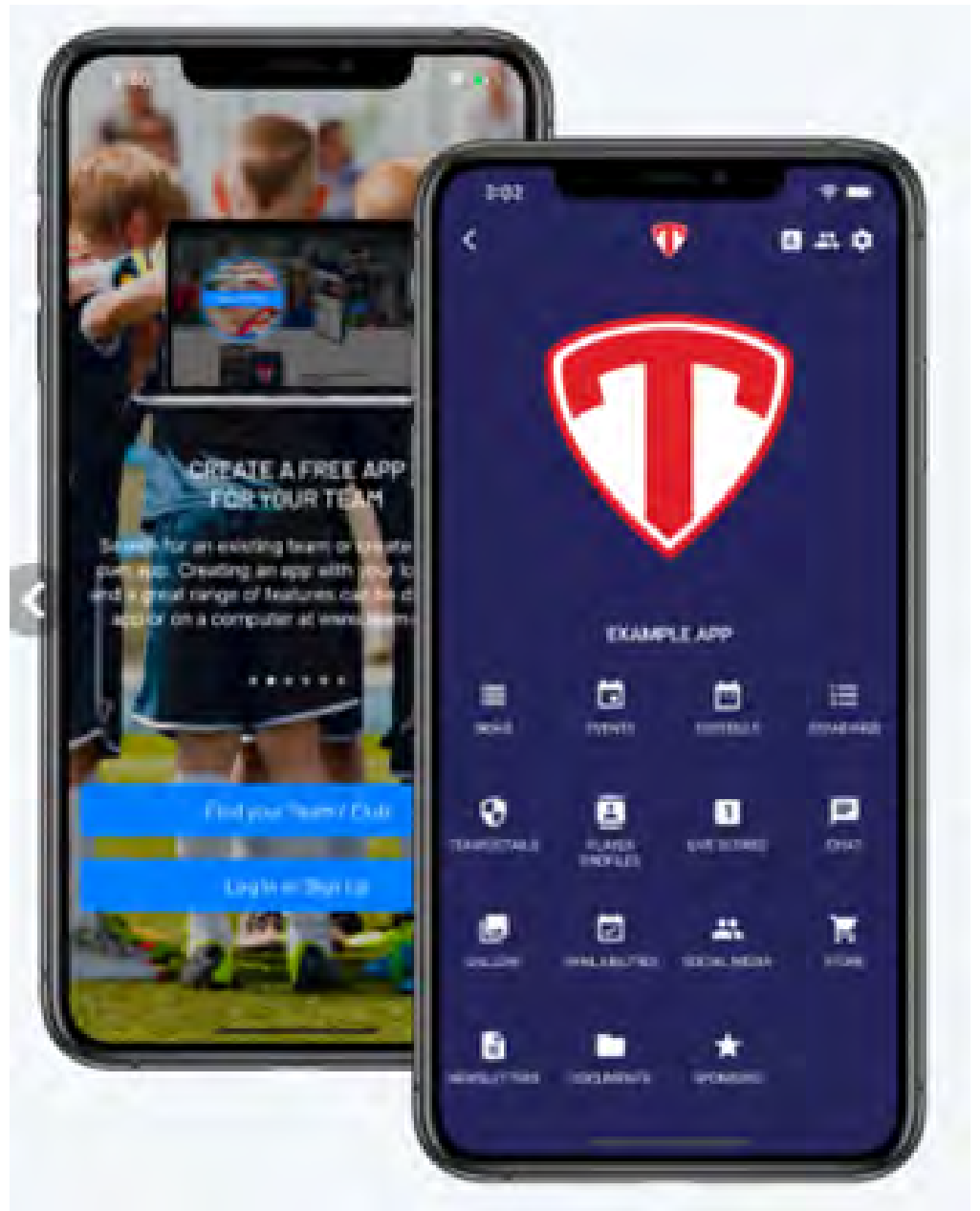
- 1. Download the Stack Team App from the Ap Store or Google Play or scan the QR code below.**

Launch Stack Team App, then:

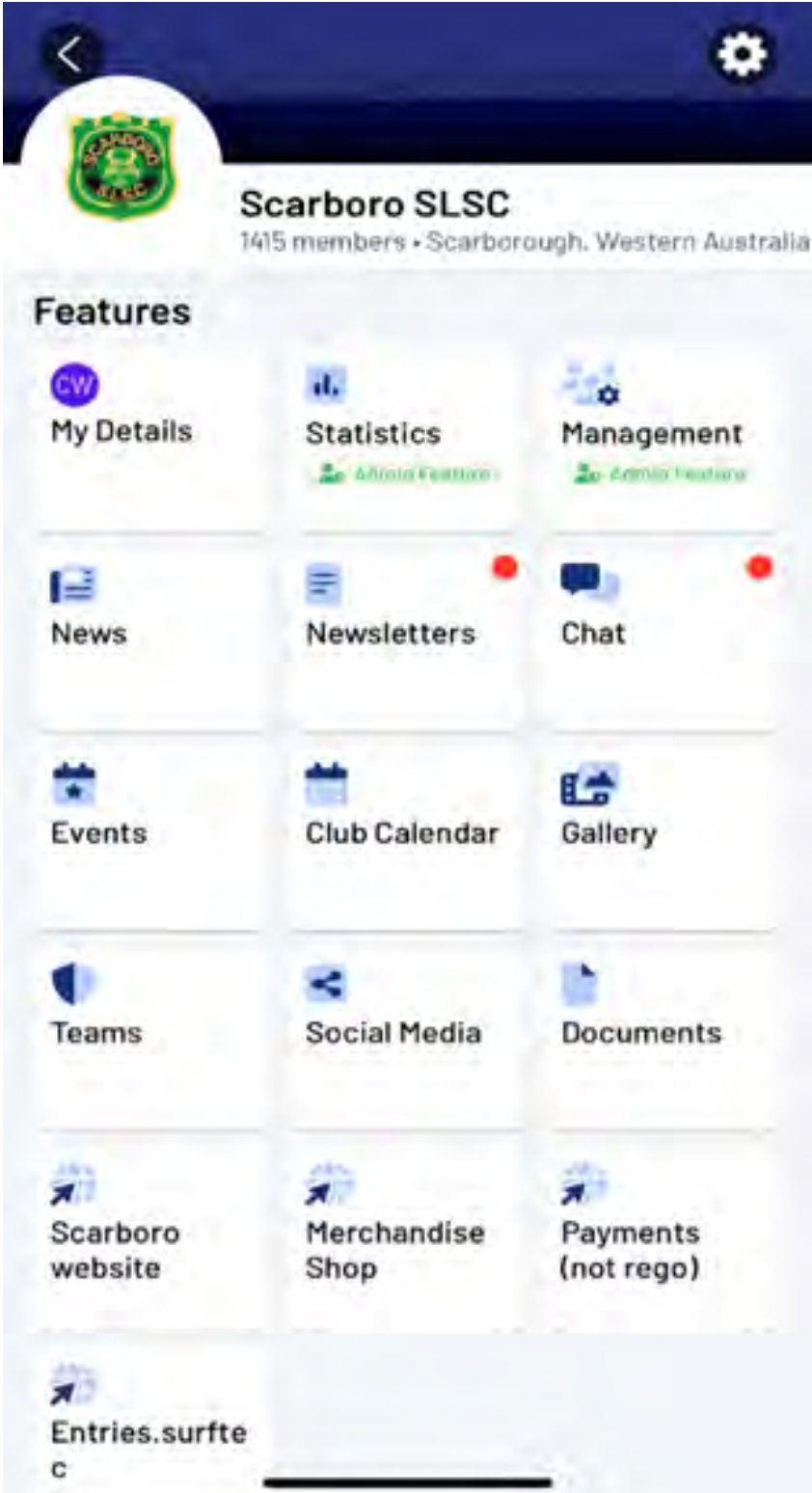
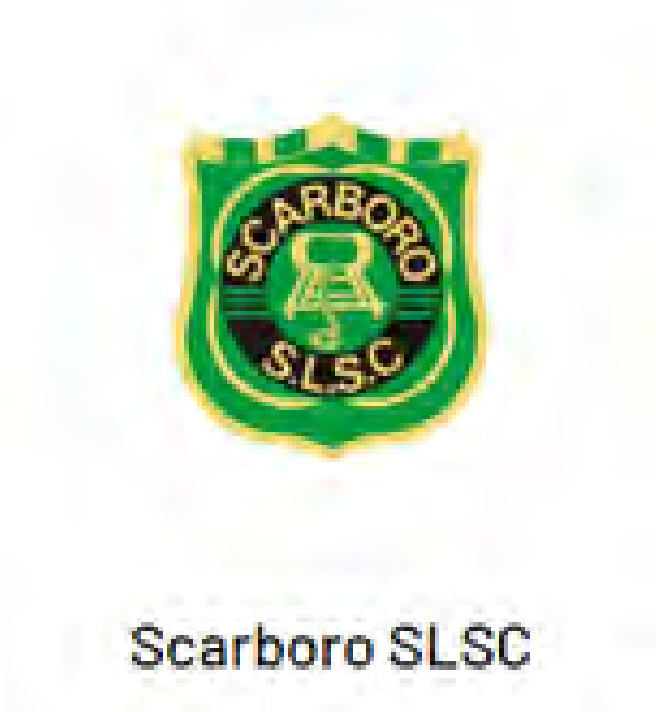
- Sign-up to Stack Team App. You'll be sent an email to confirm your registration.

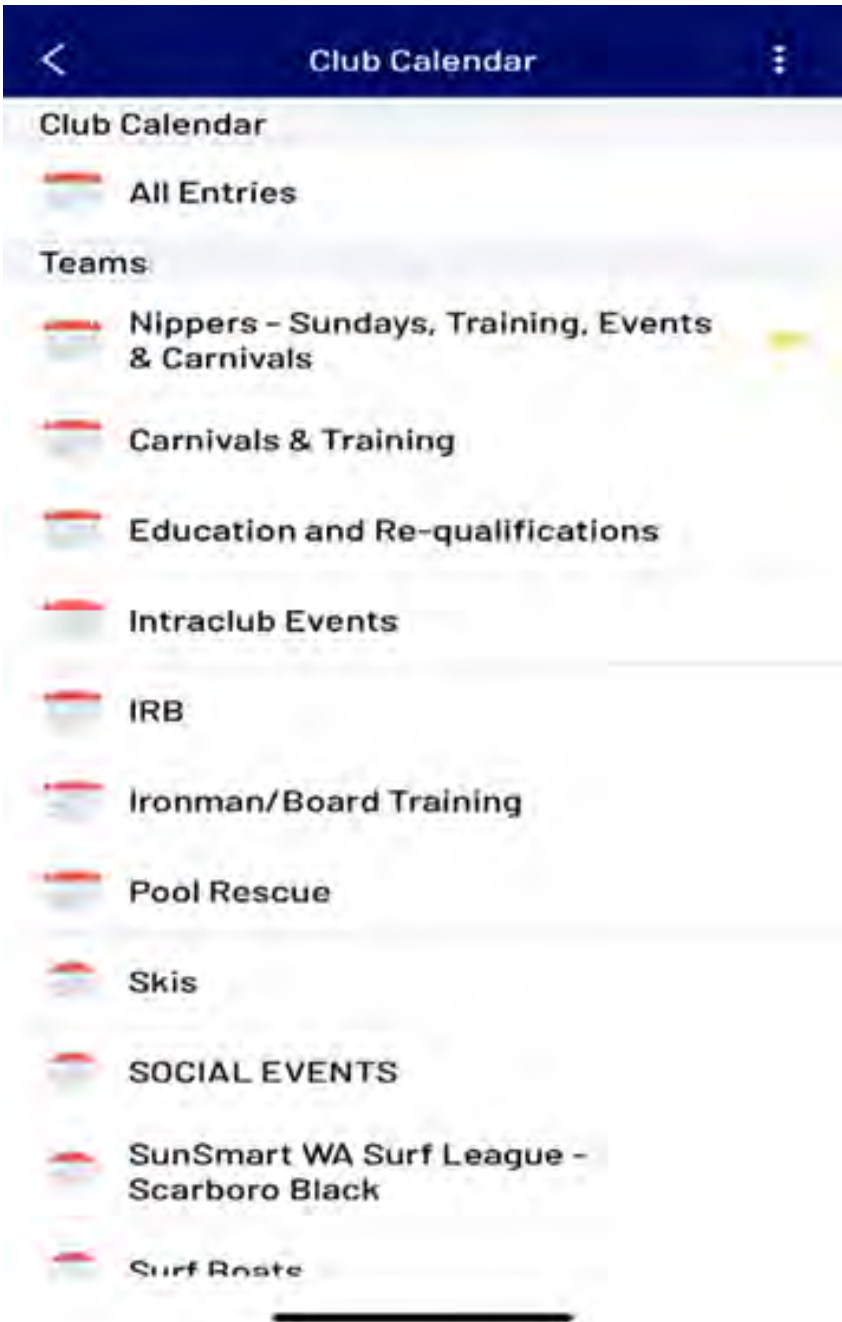

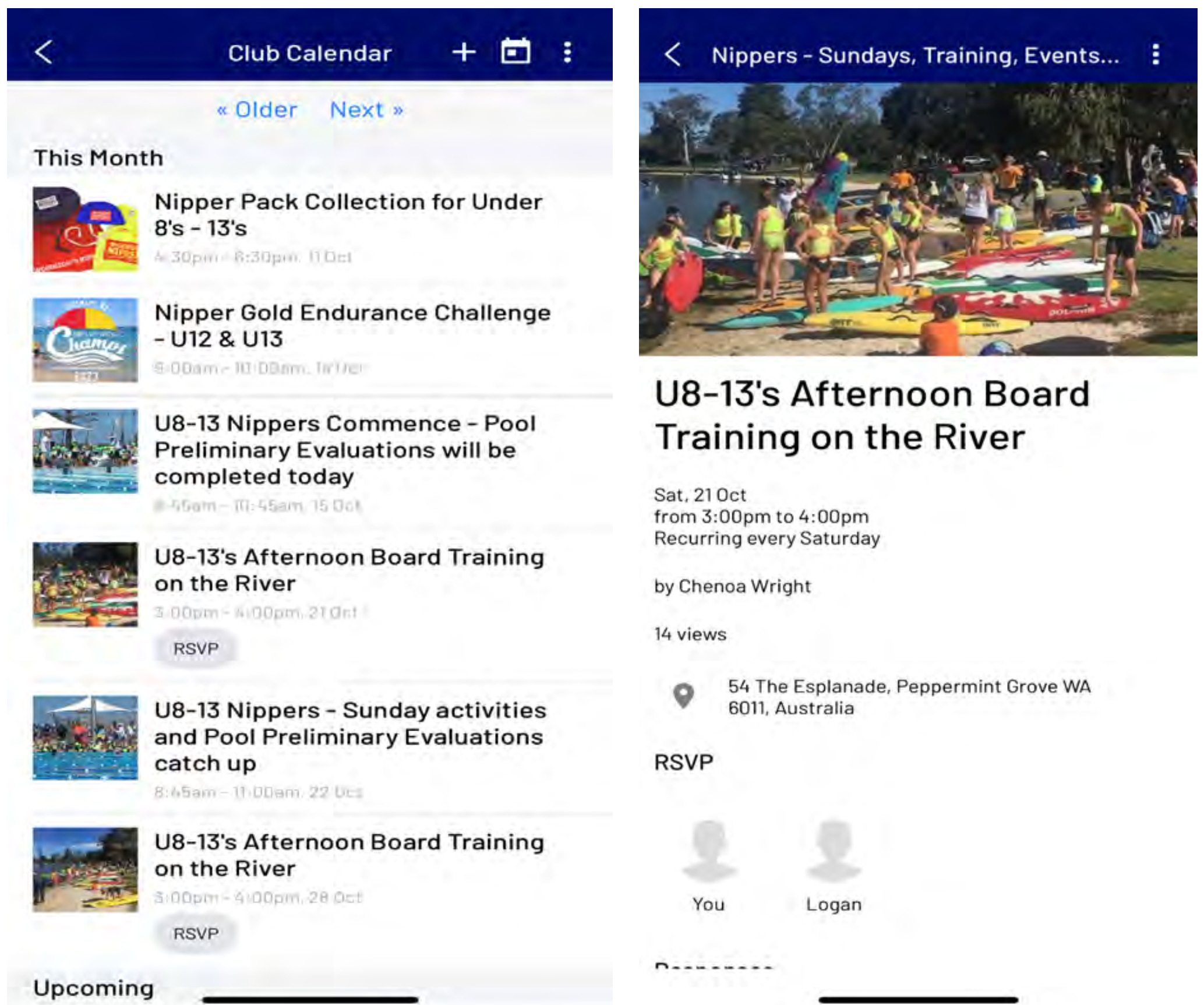

****How do you make sure you are in the right group?**

You will need to request the relevant groups of interest when you join.

Entries: surftec link is used for when you would like to enter your nipper in a carnival for their age group.
