







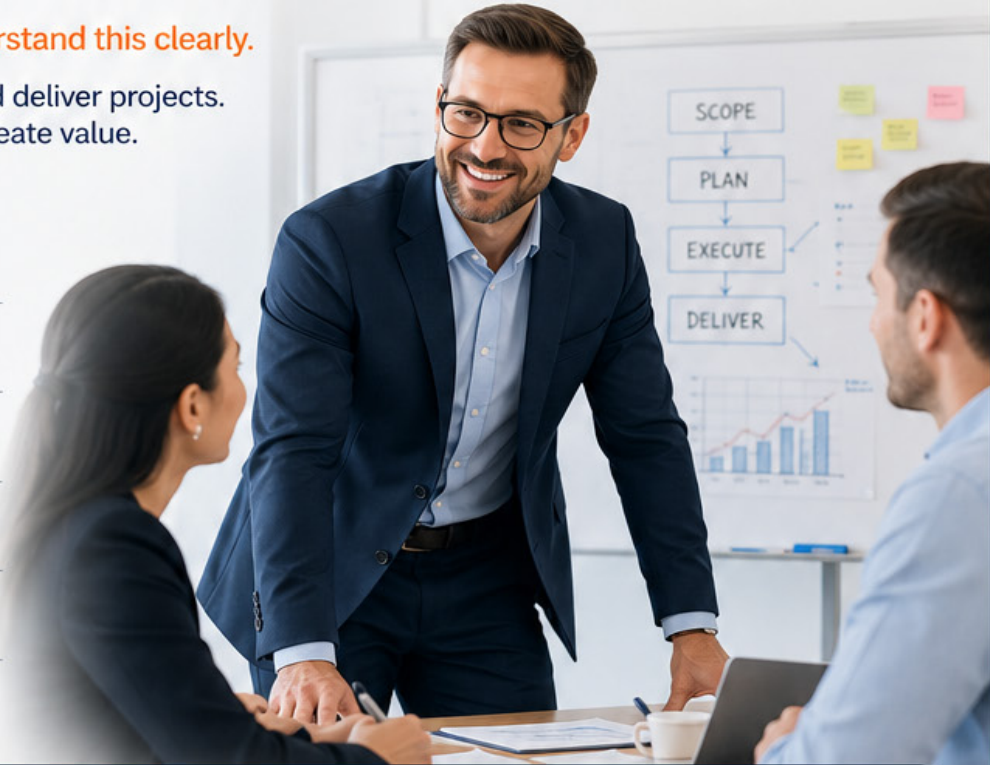
Project Managers Are Strategic Assets
