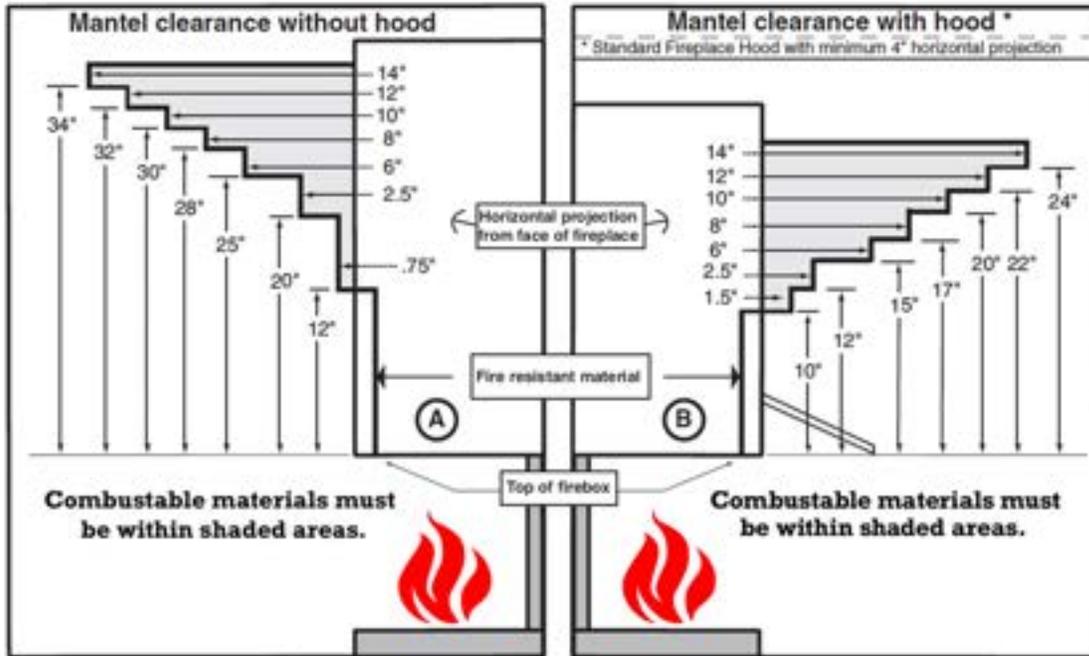

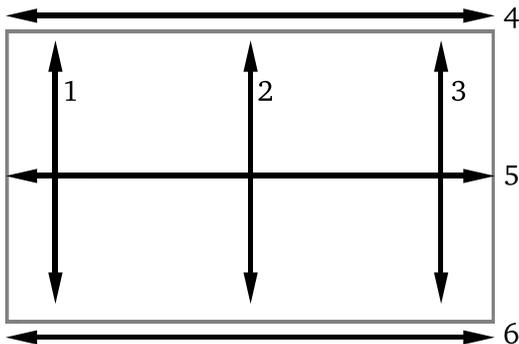

Please take the following six measurements for the opening of your fireplace. Measure carefully, without rounding up or down, to ensure the best fit.

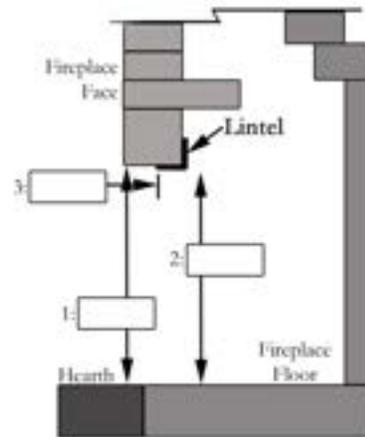
