



MUSIC MASTERS 2026 SYDNEY OPERA HOUSE

Designed by the Danish architect Jørn Utzon, this World Heritage-listed masterpiece represents a breakthrough in modern architecture. The famous sails have become a symbol of Sydney and modern Australia as a whole. From conception to completion, the building tested the limits of engineering, construction and design. When the Opera House opened its doors in 1973, a new era of cultural discovery began. Five decades later, it is the nation's leading tourism destination, one of the world's busiest performing arts centers and a community meeting place that belongs to all Australians. Its programming spans many arts forms and attracts a variety of audiences in person and online.







TOUR SUMMARY
