






Let's make this year's National Atfal Ijtema one we'll never forget!





General Guidelines


Being on the waitlist does **not** guarantee that your Tifl will be able to compete. Priority will be given to those who complete this form on a first-come, first-serve basis.
























Travel Information

Arrive before Jumu'ah on Friday, October 10.


Book return flights for **4:00 PM EST or later** on Sunday, October 12.

Packing Esentials




What to Bring

- Jama'at ID Card
- Prayer Cap and Majlis Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya Scarf
- Water bottle (labeled with your name)
- Sleeping bag, mat, and pillow
- Clothing for 3–4 days
- Sleepwear
- Towel
- Flip-flops/shower shoes
- Athletic shoes
- Fleece and rain jacket
- Toiletries (toothbrush, floss, deodorant, soap, shampoo, contact solution, etc.)
- Medicines and prescriptions (labeled)
- Insect repellent
- Extra socks
- Flashlight

What NOT to Bring

- Gaming devices, tablets, and unrelated electronics
- Valuables (e.g., expensive jewelry, cash)
- Sharp tools or pocket knives
- Fireworks or lighters
- Any item not in line with Jama'at values





Accommodations



All Atfal will sleep in a heated, padded marquee that is dedicated solely for Atfal.

Bring your own sleeping bag and mat. Limited quantities will be available for purchase or rent.



Power & Connectivity

Bring your own charging brick and cables. There are approximately 90 outlets in the marquee. Surge-protected power strips are allowed.

Cell reception is available at Baagh-e-Ahmad.



Bathrooms & Showers

Industrial-grade showers and bathrooms will be onsite. Please bring your own toiletries and towels. Showers have hot water and will be cleaned multiple times per day.

There will be separate facilities for Atfal and Khuddam.



Safety & Medical Care



Security

Atfal will be checked in at registration and only released to authorized guardians or Nazimeen.

Internal and external teams will secure the premises 24/7.



Safeguarding

A dedicated safeguarding team will be in place. Sports and activities will be monitored by staff. There will be separate accommodations and bathrooms for Atfal along with overnight supervision.

Only authorized personnel are allowed in Atfal areas.



First Aid

A first aid station will be available throughout the litema with over the counter medications such as Tylenol and Band-Aids readily available. A licensed doctor will be on duty.

Please inform the team of any medical needs in advance.



Frequently ::::: Asked Questions

- Will my child be able to call me?
 Yes, phone use is allowed and the site has cell reception.
- Can I visit the ljtema site?

 Fathers are encouraged to attend the ljtema with their Atfal. Please register yourself as well if you plan on attending.
- Are meals provided?

 Yes. All meals are provided. Please let us know if you/your Tifl has any allergies.
- What if it rains or the power goes out?

 Marquees are weather-protected. Generators are available for backup power.
