- If your local budget doesn't allow for nice meals, contact the National Atfal team and we will try our best to support your Majlis.

Work with your Murrabi Atfal and Qaid

- Qaid Majlis is encouraged to reach out to local Jamaat Tarbiyyat secretary and inform him of this New Year's Eve program. Perhaps they may want to join in and support too.

Include fun activities:
