Talking Points for Nazimeen/Murabbiyan Atfal

These are some points provided so that Nazimeen and Murabbiyan Atfal have a minimal idea of the message and theme of the class.

- Who are the most successful people in history? Many individuals come to mind, each having achieved remarkable accomplishments in fields such as sports, academics, and technology.
- Did you know: The Holy Prophet Muhammad (saw) was ranked as the MOST successful person in all of human history (by Michael H. Hart)
- The Holy Prophet Muhammad (sa) was not only successful in one aspect of life, but he is the perfect role model in every respect. He was a successful father, husband, friend, military leader, statesman, reformer, etc.
- Tazkiya means to purify oneself, improve one's morals and spirituality with the ultimate goal to develop a relation with Allah.

Activity: My Beloved Prophet (saw)
