Successful Rolemodel in every aspect of life

The Promised Messiah (as) states:

The Promised Messiah (as) states:



What is Tazkiya'?

What is Tazkiya?

Tazkiya means to purify oneself, improve one's morals and spirituality with the ultimate goal to develop a relation with Allah.

Hence, the Holy Quran tells us that to be successful we must continue to purify ourselves, improve our morals and try to develop a relationship with Allah.

Remember this is a gradual process.

How can we follow this?

But how do we purify ourselves?

Muhammad (sa) - The Great Purifier

The Holy Quran States:

He it is Who has raised among the Unlettered people a Messenger from among themselves who recites unto them His Signs, and **purifies them**

The Promised Messiah (as) states:

Treading upon the path that the Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings be upon him) laid out before mankind even for ten days ignites such spiritual light within a person that similar effects cannot be attained through the efforts of a thousand years before his advent.

'My Beloved Prophet (saw)' Activity

Each child places a note on a poster, answering the question: What is one special thing that helped the Holy Prophet (saw) be successful and overcome challenges?

- Each child gets a sticky note and writes one thing that helped the Holy Prophet (saw) be successful and overcome challenges.
- They place the note on a white poster titled with the activity name.
- After everyone has added their note, go through them together and ask each child briefly why they chose their answer.
- End with a short reflection that success comes through the example and teachings of the Holy Prophet (saw).
