Talking Points for Nazimeen/Murabbiyan Atfal

*These are some points provided so that Nazimeen and Murabbiyan Atfal have a minimal idea of the message and theme of the class. Please refer to the SlideDeck, as many of the points not on the presentation are there***

Islamic guidance on speaking with kindness:

- Uqbah bin Amirra narrated: “I said: ‘O Messenger of Allah! What is the means to salvation?’ He said: ‘That you control your tongue, suffice yourself your house, and cry over your sins.’”
- Once Hazrat Khadija (rah) said to the Holy Prophet (saw) that he is kind and considerate to his relations and treats guests with honor; God will not allow you to be wasted away.
- The Holy Prophet (saw) never said ‘Uff’ to anyone.
- The Promised Messiah (as) always received others with a cheerful face.
- The Promised Messiah (as) never liked when someone made a joke meant to hurt someone and would stop such act to happen.
- Huzoor (aba) said to Atfal, if you uphold good moral standards, say good things and be good students it will have a lasting effect on others that would be good for Tabligh.

Teach the Atfal to wear proper attire

- *He should not wear graphic t-shirts, especially that display which are not appropriate. Nor wear gold (or any kind of) chains, and earrings.*
- *Explain reasoning behind it (these things for women)*

Slide 15

Huzur (aba) said:

- *"One should wear simple clothes to the mosque. The clothes should not feature company logos, pictures, cartoons, or animal designs.*
- *Since we cover pictures in front of us during prayer, our clothes should also be plain.*
- *If someone is wearing a shirt or vest with such designs, they should wear a plain jacket over it."*

- *Discussing the etiquettes of hygiene is essential, especially when considering the exemplary lifestyle of the Holy Prophet (saw). He emphasized the importance of cleanliness, both physically and spiritually.*
- *The Prophet (saw) would make a conscious effort to ensure he was well-dressed and pleasant-smelling, particularly for Friday prayers, Jumah. He would bathe, apply perfume, and wear his best clothes, setting a beautiful example for his followers.*
- *This demonstrated not only respect for the sacredness of the day but also consideration for those around him.*
