### **FOOD SERVICE WORKER** **(EXTERNAL)**

**Stó:lō Service Agency (SSA)** requires the services of a **Food Services Worker** to fill a term position with the **Health Services Team**. This position is funded by the **Targeted Wage Subsidy (TWS) Program**. Pursuant to section 41 of the BC Human Rights Code, preference may be given to applicants of Aboriginal ancestry. Please self-identify on your cover letter or resume.

#### **Funded by the Targeted Wage Subsidy (TWS) Program, to be eligible, you:**

- Must be Indigenous status/non-status, reside on or off reserve, within SASET catchment area (i.e., the geographic area from Katzie/Langley to Boston Bar and three First Nation communities which are part of the Lower Stl'at'imx Tribal Council: Samahquam, Skatin and Xa'xtsa).
- Must be 18 years of age or older (not currently in school) unemployed.
- Are currently not receiving other funding from Service Canada.
- Must be legally entitled to work in Canada and have a valid social insurance number.

This position will support the Elders Programs, Health-related Programs, and Staff Wellness Programs by preparing and serving nutritious meals and refreshments that promote health, cultural connection, and community well-being. The Food Services Worker will work in accordance with Public Health standards for safe food handling, preparation, and service and will uphold SSA's Vision, Mission and Values and provide service in a "Good Way" as a valued member of the interdisciplinary team.

The successful candidate will work out of the Chilliwack office - Building 7 - and will report to the Health Services Executive Assistant.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS:**

- Completion of Food Safe with current certification.
- Experience supporting community-based programs, Elders gatherings, or health-related initiatives is an asset.
- Strong work ethic with foundational knowledge, demonstrating high potential for immediate contribution and professional growth.
- Knowledge of basic nutrition principles and special diets (e.g., diabetic, low sodium, heart healthy) is an asset.
- Culinary training is an asset.
- Must maintain a safe work environment by adhering to health and safety guidelines and emergency procedures.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills with the ability to build meaningful relationships with Elders, community members, and staff.
- Physically able to perform duties as required, including lifting and prolonged standing.
- Must have strong organizational skills, be hardworking, a team player, and be an excellent communicator, both verbally and in writing.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality guidelines for all records, materials and communications concerning clients, staff and SSA.

#### **Successful candidates will be required to provide the following if screened in for an interview:**

- Professional references: Names and email addresses of two references.
- Proof of education documentation.
- Must Successfully Pass the required pre- employment Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General Check.
- Ability to work occasional evening and weekends.

**SALARY RANGE:** **\$23.00 - \$25.00** per hour based on qualifications/experience.

**TYPE OF POSITION:** **Full-Time 1 year term April - March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2027 position with benefits**, subject to 3-month probationary period and planned performance evaluations.
