Stó:lō Service Agency (SSA) requires the services of a qualified **Mental Health Support Worker** to fill a vacancy with the **Health Services Department**. Pursuant to section 41 of the BC Human Rights Code, preference may be given to applicants of Aboriginal ancestry. Please self-identify on your cover letter or resume.

The **Mental Health Support worker** delivers direct, community-based, and relational care to Indigenous clients within the ÍMEXYÓSEM Program facing mental health and substance use challenges. Reporting to the Mental Health Support Unit (MHSU) Clinical Lead and collaborating with Caseworkers, this role ensures holistic, integrated support, focusing on practical assistance, client well-being, and consistent day-to-day connection. All services are delivered in a "Good Way," adhering to SSA's core values and the 7 Spiritual Laws of Life: Health (Self-care), Humility, Happiness, Understanding, Forgiveness, Generations, and Generosity.

QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS:

- Certificate or Diploma in a relevant field such as Community Support Work, Social Services, Youth Work, Health Care, or Indigenous Studies — OR an equivalent combination of education, training, and lived/professional experience.
- Minimum 1 year of experience working with individuals affected by mental health and/or substance use challenges.
- Proficiency in Microsoft 365 (Word, Outlook, Excel) and video conferencing platforms.
- Knowledge of Indigenous communities, cultural safety, and Truth and Reconciliation principles.
- Ability to develop and nurture healthy professional relationships with team supervisors, consultants, social workers, counselors, traditional healers, nurses, community health workers and elders.
- Must have the ability to maintain the confidentiality guidelines of all records, materials and communications concerning clients, staff and SSA.
- Current WHIMIS, Safe Food Handling, CPR & AED certification (preferred).
- Completion of relevant peer support, crisis response, or trauma-informed care training (Preferred)

Successful candidates will be required to provide the following if screened in for an interview:

- Proof of education documentation.
- Professional references: Names and email addresses of two references
- Must possess and maintain a valid Class 5 BC Drivers' License
- Must successfully pass the required pre-employment RCMP Criminal records Check.

SALARY RANGE:

Starting wage \$28.00 per hour (based on qualifications/experience).

Full-time or Part-time with benefits, subject to 3-month probationary period and planned performance evaluations.
