

Gender and Youth Engagement Pledge Campaign | Advancing Commitments for Inclusive Agrifood Research and Innovation in Africa

Background

Women and young people are central to Africa's agrifood systems, contributing to food production, research, innovation, entrepreneurship, and policymaking. Despite their significant role, **they remain underrepresented** in leadership, decision-making, funding opportunities, and institutional governance. While continental and global frameworks including the Malabo Declaration, the Kampala Declaration, Agenda 2063, and various African Union and European Union commitments have called for greater investment in and inclusion of women and youth, translating these commitments into institutional action remains a challenge.

To address this, the CEA-FIRST project, through the International Research Consortium (IRC) on Food, Nutrition Security and Sustainable Agriculture (FNSSA), has developed a **Gender and Youth Strategy** to strengthen the integration of gender and youth considerations across **research, innovation, policy, and institutional processes, fostering greater participation of women and young professionals in shaping inclusive and sustainable agrifood systems**. To translate this Strategy into tangible action, Young Professionals for Agricultural Development (YPARD) and the CEA-FIRST is leading a practical pledge campaign.

The Gender and Youth Engagement Pledge Campaign

The campaign calls all institutions participating in AASW to:

Publicly commit to at least one action that advances gender equality and youth inclusion over the next twelve months. The campaign seeks to **promote institutional ownership, accountability, and collective action** towards more inclusive agrifood research and innovation systems in Africa.
