## Feliciano tour guide panama

While many people say he's very nice, I have to warn women especially that he's not someone you should be alone with. He seems charming at first, but things changed quickly when we went for a walk together. He kept touching me, starting with just my hand and then moving up to my arms, shoulders, and legs, even after I asked him to stop. And then there was the machete joke about chopping off my legs - that was unsettling. But what really scared me was his obsession with Northern European women. I didn't feel safe around him. Despite those feelings, our guides did a great job with Feliciano leading us on two hikes over three days in mid-July. He's very knowledgeable about the area and knows the local communities, plants, and animals well. His tours were tailored to what we wanted, and he shared interesting stories along the way. He even showed us his home, where he takes care of nature and grows organic bananas from his garden. His fees are reasonable, and it's clear he loves sharing his passion with others. I would recommend him, but only if you have someone with you. The morning hike was cut short due to heavy rain, which made the path slippery. Although Feliciano was keen to continue, we decided to head back after making progress halfway up. To make up for lost time, he offered to take us to other attractions in Boquete, showcasing his generous and professional nature. Our second tour took us to the main waterfall in Boquete, which was breathtakingly beautiful and just the right level of challenge. The dense forest surroundings made it feel like a scene from the movie Avatar. The third tour allowed us to relax and unwind at the Caldera hot spring, where we alternated between the warm water and a nearby cold river for a leisurely afternoon. However, what truly made the experience unforgettable was Feliciano himself. After I developed a neck cramp during the initial waterfall hike, he helped me by applying pressure and then drove us to the pharmacy to get relief cream. He even accompanied me to the hot springs, which significantly eased my discomfort. His concern and care for my well-being were exceptional.
