Out-of-game EVE data access is provided by CCP through the EVE Swagger Interface (ESI), but this method can be inconvenient for casual users. Fortunately, third-party services like EVEMarketer offer better access to market data. EVEMarketer's API provides similar functionality to EVE Central's previous service but with some differences. To use the EVEMarketer API, you need an item identifier (typeID) and optional parameters to limit data to a specific system or region. The API call requires a POST or GET method and returns data in either XML (/marketstat) or JSON (/marketstat/json) formats. For casual users, constructing API calls can be challenging. However, the EVEMarketer API provides an endpoint that accepts these methods and returns data without requiring any additional tools or knowledge. Google Sheets uses the IMPORTXML function to retrieve data from an API and process XML. This function requires two parameters: the API URL and the XML field to retrieve. The API URL can be constructed by combining different parts, such as the typeid and usesystem. The IMPORTXML function can be used with other cell functions (like CONCATENATE, INDEX, LOOKUP) to automate market data retrieval based on cell references. Examples of using this function include: * Retrieving the median buy price for a specific item type * Getting the minimum sell price for an item in a specific location (e.g. Jita) * Calculating the volume of sell orders for multiple item types Note that the API has a limit of 200 items per call.
