changeover /tʃeɪndʒ,əʊvə/ noun a change from one activity, system, or way of working to another. Change over and change to are two phrases that can convey a similar meaning but have distinct contexts in their usage. While they can be used interchangeably, there is a subtle difference between them. Change over implies a transition from one thing to another, suggesting a more dramatic or complete shift, such as changing phones or careers. On the other hand, change to implies a shift towards something new, often with the intention of replacing or substituting an existing entity, like switching from one device to another. The choice between these phrases depends on the context in which they are used, and both can convey the same overall meaning when the context is clear.
