NATO sizes are 6-digit numbers representing metric cm sizing for different body parts. They're used in Europe and are essential to understand for choosing the right size when buying army products. The NATO size chart consists of two main sections: shirts/jackets and trousers. Shirts and jackets are sized as 'xxx/yy', where 'xxx' represents full height in cms and 'yy' represents chest size in cms. Trousers are sized as 'xx/yy/zz', with 'xx' representing waist size in cms, 'yy' representing inner leg size in cms, and 'zz' representing seat size in cms. The British Army uniform has 16 categories, with the most common being the Number 8 Combat Uniform. This uniform is designed to blend in with various environments and comes with different colored berets for different regiments. To determine your NATO size, use our conversion chart or a similar one. Once you have your regular UK sizing measurements in inches, follow along the chart to find your NATO size. NATO clothing can be worn for airsoft, but make sure to choose the correct sizes to ensure proper fit. Understanding how NATO sizes are displayed will help you determine which size you need. The clothing is sized by taking multiple measurements from different parts of the garment. Shirts/Jackets/Smocks come with two sets of numbers separated by a /, such as 170/96, 180/106, or 190/120. The first set relates to the wearer's height in centimeters, while the second set corresponds to their chest measurement. The most common size is 180cm, which corresponds to an average height of 5'9" (175 cm). Combat Trousers have three sets of numbers: inseam, waist, and seat size. Please note that some brands may not include seat size measurements in their sizing charts. Leg lengths range from 75-112cm, while waist sizes vary from 72-116cm.
