Of course, you can always create your own question cards to make the game even more personalized! To start playing, players take turns rolling the dice to see who gets to go first. Roll again for the highest score, and that's who starts the game! The game begins with all players' playing pieces outside the board, with square one serving as the starting point for counting turns. Pieces can occupy the same square. There's no bonus turn for rolling a six. On each turn, players roll the dice and move their piece according to the number rolled. When landing on a square with a ladder's foot, players climb up to the top. For squares containing a snake's head, they slide down to the tail. Squares marked with symbols require an answer to a question from the corresponding card pile. Correct answers allow players to stay; incorrect ones send them back to their previous position. Ladders and symbols follow similar rules. If a player lands on a square without a symbol, they can remain without answering questions. The game concludes when a player reaches square 100, with two possible paths: either roll the exact number or move to 94+ and wait for the required number, or move directly to 100 then backtrack according to the rolled dice number. Choose one of these rules at the start of the game.
