Students must research proper conjugations and learn about 10 important verbs. This worksheet focuses on the present tense. For the second exercise, students must fill in the text using the correct irregular verb conjugation in parentheses. To practice more, they can work in pairs to write a paragraph using these verbs and any others they know. Level: Beginners; Skill: Grammar; Related lessons: Fill in the blanks with the correct form of each irregular verb in Spanish to complete short sentences. Some irregular yo verbs in Spanish include hacer, dar, poner, saber, and salir. These verbs do not follow the standard conjugation pattern for regular verbs in the first person singular form of the present tense. Examples of how these irregular yo verbs are used: * Yo hago estos ejercicios. (I do these exercises.) * Yo sé un poco de español. (I know a little Spanish.) * Yo veo a Pablo todos los días. (I see Pablo every day.) In addition, most verbs that end in -cer or -cir also have irregular yo forms. Examples include: * Aparecer: Yo aparezco * Conocer: Yo conozco * Conducir: Yo conduzco * Ofrecer: Yo ofrezco * Producir: Yo produzco * Traducir: Yo traduzco These irregular forms are used in specific contexts and must be memorized to accurately convey meaning in Spanish.
