However, calling in last minute or missing work on a key date will result in getting three points added to your record. This is significant because after getting five points within six months, you can be fired. Key event dates are important days for the store, often including holidays and sales events like Black Friday and Valentine's Day. It's crucial for employees to know about these days so they can prepare or plan ahead if they don't want to work them.
