The Shadowhunters Tarot Deck is a unique interpretation of traditional tarot cards, featuring characters from The Shadowhunter Chronicles. Original decks were illustrated by Cassandra Jean, while new ones are being created by Gabriella Bujoso. The first deck featured characters from various series, including The Mortal Instruments, Infernal Devices, Dark Artifices, and Last Hours. A new deck will focus solely on the Major Arcana, using characters from The Last Hours. The deck has 79 cards, with an extra Fool card, and uses Shadowhunter terminology to translate traditional tarot terms: Blades (Swords), Steles (Wands), Cups (Runes), and Pentacles (Rings). Despite this, card numbers still correlate with original tarot card numbers. Some card explanations can be found online. The Major Arcana includes cards such as The Warlock (Magician), Believer (High Priestess), Warrior (Empress), Artist (Emperor), Hierophant/Priest/Shaman/Pope, and Strength/Fortitude/Lust. Magnus and Alec, Jace and Clary take on the Lovers Card, symbolizing love. Cassandra Jean's Shadowhunter Tarot series continues with Jem, accompanied by his beloved violin, embodying Temperance. Tessa takes The Star card, while Simon represents the Sun Card as a Daylighter. Alec and Isabelle embody the Tower Card, with the Institute serving as the background. The Major Arcana suit of Swords is replaced by Seraph Blades, with Jonathan as King, Jocelyn as Queen, Young Valentine as Knight, and Young Hodge as Page. The twins Livia and Tiberius, or Livvy and Ty, are featured in Cassandra Jean's Shadowhunter Tarot. Although most Blackthorns share similar physical characteristics, Ty stands out with his black hair and gray eyes. He's 15 years old, skinny, and aspiring to be a detective like Sherlock Holmes. Clary takes the World card, while Sebastian represents Death. In honor of Clockwork Princess, Henry and Charlotte from Infernal Devices take on the Fool and Justice cards respectively. Nate is featured in the seven of Swords, and Jessamine in the eight of Swords. Jem's depiction by Cassandra Jean captures his essence perfectly. The six of Swords/Blades card signifies a long journey, fitting Jem's travels from Shanghai to England. The two of Blades/Swords represents an impossible choice. Raphael, the angel-faced vampire with mysterious intentions, is featured in the seven of Steles, which can be ambiguous. He has a significant role in City of Heavenly Fire. Will takes on the Nine of Steles card. There's room for everyone in this complete deck of characters from the Shadowhunter series. Your favorite character might not have shown up yet, but they will eventually. A little clue about Clockwork Princes can be found here if you take a closer look. Some less frequently seen characters include Herondales like the Inquisitor, Stephen's son with Amatis (Luke's sister), and Mark, who has faerie blood through his mother. Mark also possesses the Tarot Card of the Chariot. Next up is Julian, who takes care of everyone for reasons that will be explained later in City of Heavenly Fire. Julian is an artist with brown hair and blue-green eyes, similar to most of his siblings. He paints mostly in oils and watercolors. His art reflects what he loves, which often includes the ocean. More information about Emma and Cristina, who have already been introduced, is provided below. Emma Carstairs is a Shadowhunter who's very proud of her role and very determined. She trains extensively and is determined to find out what happened to her parents — this will be revealed in CoHF. Emma owns an important weapon. Julian and Emma are parabatai, having known each other forever. They communicate almost silently and sleep together. Julian grounds Emma with his calm presence. Cristina Rosales is a friend of Emma's who came from Mexico City. Cristina's name was inspired by two different girls who attended a signing in Mexico City years ago. She's shy but strong and unwavering in her faith, wearing a medallion that says Blessed be the Angel, which teaches her strength. She's very dedicated to her family too, they're super important :) Then there's more info about Tiberius (Ty) and Livia (Livvy) Blackthorn - the twins. They come after Jules in age. My best friend had twins a year ago so she's been going on and on about them nonstop. I sometimes stare at her twins creepily hoping they'll give me some Important Tinformation. Ty's the slightly older one, he has black hair and gray eyes, which is different from most of his family. He doesn't really care about fighting; he loves mystery books and Sherlock Holmes and wants to be a detective. Most people don't have patience for a fifteen year old Shadowhunter who wants to dust for fingerprints so he mostly gets along with no one but...his sister Livvy. They're super close, they even had their own twin language that only they can understand. Livvy's the "protector" because she protects Ty from everything since he's hopeless at fighting and she's a skilled fencer and swordfighter. She also helps him out when he finds other people's behavior confusing. Cassandra's website features the Mortal Sword and Herondale boys, with Simon and Izzy taking center stage. They embody unity and breakthroughs, as represented by the Ace of Swords/Blades. The illustration also highlights Glorious, worthy of being the Ace of Blades. As for fan requests, Cassandra listened and delivered, including a Magnus card and a prototype Ragnar card. The Magician major arcana card is fittingly paired with Magnus. A Jace and Alec card might be coming soon, but for now, fans can enjoy symbolic scenes like this one featuring Jem and Tessa. The scene doesn't take place in any specific location, but rather serves as a representation of their love story. Cassandra saved the Jem and Tessa card to avoid spoiling future events in unwritten books. Tessa's Ten of Runes illustration represents her wedded union with Will, while the daisies surrounding them symbolize loyal love and patience. The scene takes place during CoHF, TDA, or between the two, but its exact timing is unknown. As for fan questions regarding Jem and Tessa's family life, it's possible they could have children, but becoming mortal or immortal carries a significant price in this world.
