Sermon

Indestructible Adventure - Pastor Josh Hotsenpiller

<u>Scriptures:</u> Genesis 1:1-5, 26-28; Psalm 8:6, 139:13-14; Colossians 3:10; Ephesians 2:10; Romans 5:8; Isaiah 45:18; 1 Corinthians 14:33; Joshua 1:9.

Context:

We will never live out our God-given destiny if we don't live out our Identity.

- Identity "I am made in God's image."
- Chaos Uncertainty sparks adventure.
- Order Clarity sustains the adventure. "Start with the end in mind."
- Dominion Authority leads the adventure "I am called to bring God's kingdom on earth."

1. What are you amazing at?

Questions

Observation: What does the passage say?

- 1. Read Genesis 1:1 and 1:26-28. What actions and events are taking place? Who is involved in the passage?
- 2. What words or themes from the passage/message stand out to you and why?
- 3. Was there anything about the passage/message that didn't make sense to you?

Interpretation: What does the passage mean?

- 1. Pastor Josh taught us that our God-given identity is central to living out God's destiny for us. Read through the following passages as a group and consider what these teach us about our God-given identity: Psalm 8:4-6; 139:13-14; 1 Corinthians 14:33; Ephesians 2:10; Colossians 3:10.
- 2. Read Romans 5:6-8. How has God stepped into our chaos and brought clarity and order? How does this passage relate to the gospel?

3. Read Isaiah 5:6-8. How can we sum up the main truth of this passage?

Application: How can we apply these passages to our lives?

- 1. What challenged you the most from this week? What encouraged you the most?
- 2. CHAOS: What is a situation or circumstance in your life that feels like stepping into the unknown or feels out of your control?
- 3. ORDER: Read Joshua 1:8-9. How does this passage correct your understanding of who you are to the LORD and how does it help you step into the situation or circumstance you just described?
- 4. How can you start with the end in mind? What kind of follower of Jesus would you like to be 3 years from now?
- 5. DOMINION: What is one action you can take this week to take authority of your life and respond in surrender and obedience to the LORD?
