Sermon

Faith Is A Fragment - Pastor Josh Hotsenpiller

Scriptures: Hebrews 11:1; Exodus 33:19-23; Matthew 8:5-10

Context: As we continue our "Indestructible" series, Pastor Josh taught on Indestructible Faith: Faith without Fear. While fear is Kryptonite, faith is the antidote to fear.

Mixer

1. Tell about a time when you placed your faith in something that was not reliable.
2. Share about a time when you trusted God for something and He came through.

Questions

Observation: What does the passage say?

1. Read Hebrews 11:1. How does this verse define faith?
2. Read Exodus 33:19. What do we learn about God from this verse?
3. Read Matthew 8:5-10. How does this passage describe the faith of the Centurion?

Interpretation: What does the passage mean?

1. (Exodus 33:19-23) Why are these attributes of God important for us? Why do you think God prevented Moses from seeing "ALL" of His Glory?
2. (Hebrews 11:1 and Matthew 8:5-10) What does the faith of the Centurion teach "us" about faith?

3. What does it mean that God has authority over all things?

Application: How can we apply these passages to our lives?

1. What was your primary takeaway from Pastor Josh's message?
2. Pastor Josh declared that we were to walk out of the Worship Center with a posture of faith. Did you? Why or why not?
3. In what area(s) of your life do you need less fear and more faith in God? What steps can/will you take to increase your faith?
4. THIS WEEK: Think about those things in your life you are allowing fear to get a foothold. Pray for God to increase your faith...a faith that is indestructible - one that truly believes the words of the Apostle John in 1 John 4:4,

"You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them (fear, anxiety, doubt, worry), because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in this world."*
