Observation: What does the passage say?

1. Read Proverbs 14:12, 19:3, 2:16-18. Solomon teaches us that the way of God is very unnatural. How do these passages show the natural inclinations of man?

Interpretation: What does the passage mean?

1. When the world says you are foolish to live with God, why do you listen to the world?
2. Why does life seem comfortable at times to keep one foot in the world and one foot in God's order?
3. What do you need to do to understand the order of God?

Application: How can we apply these passages to our lives?

1. What did this message tell you you need to do?
2. With the offer of God's grace, and with the power of the Spirit of God, how does that enable change?
