Discussion Questions

Observation: What does the passage say?

1. Read **Hebrews 9:6-10**. What does this passage tell us about the first tabernacle?
2. Read **Hebrews 9:11-13**. Compare and contrast the first tabernacle with the "greater and more perfect tabernacle."
3. Read **Hebrews 10:19-22**. What is the significance of the blood of Jesus?

Interpretation: What does the passage mean?

1. Pastor Jared asked this question: Why did Jesus have to die?

Application: How can we apply these passages to our lives?

1. Do you understand the impact of the cross? Why does it have to be so messy?
2. Why is it easier to celebrate Easter than acknowledge the blood of the cross?
3. If the "train" coming at you means certain destruction because of your uncleanness, why don't you move and let Jesus take the brunt?
4. Why do we cling more to our uncleanness than we do to the blood washing?
5. How will you wear the blood sacrifice of your High Priest moving forward?

Huddles

Break into small groups of 3-4 people of the same gender for deeper sharing, accountability, and prayer.

- How have you seen or enjoyed God's grace this week?
- How has anger, fear, anxiety, selfishness, or addiction shown up in your life this week? How have those moments revealed what you're really trusting in?
- Who is someone in your life who needs Jesus? How will you have conversations around faith with them or share the good news of the gospel?
