Scripture Reading

Acts 2:1-13; Romans 8:22-23; Exodus 33:18-19, 34:6-7

Sermon Recap & Prayer

We need the fullness of God's Spirit. In Acts 2:1-13, the first Christians received a taste of the power of the Holy Spirit through wind and fire. Even though our world is headed towards death and decay, we have power over the things that are holding us down! We have a taste of the transcendent power of the Holy Spirit which will be recognized in its fullness upon Christ's return!

Discussion Questions

Observation: What does the passage say?

1. Read **Exodus 33:18-19** and **34:6-7**, and **Acts 2:1-13**. What do these passages say about God's distant presence and personal presence?
2. How did God's power move from the mountain to the people?
3. In **Romans 8:22-23**, what does it say we are waiting for?

Interpretation: What does the passage mean?

1. In **Exodus 33:19**, God said, "I will cause all my goodness to pass in front of you." Why do you think God expanded on this (His mercy and compassion) in the remainder of the verse?
2. What does it mean when God says in **Exodus 33:20**, "You cannot see my face, for no one may see me and live"?
3. In **Acts 2:12**, the people asked, "What does this mean?" What did it mean?

Application: How can we apply these passages to our lives?

1. In **Acts 2**, the disciples were "all together in one place." How can our circle group come together in unity to be more effective for the kingdom?
2. John Newton said, "I am not what I ought to be, I am not what I wish to be; but by the grace of God I am not what I was." Once we chose to follow Christ, what are some of the ways we have power to become something more than we were?
3. Do you believe in the power of the Spirit in your life? It is available to all of us! What step can and will you take this week toward experiencing the power of the Holy Spirit over a habit you're trying to break?

Huddles

Break into small groups of 3-4 people of the same gender for deeper sharing, accountability, and prayer.

- Pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit on your group.
- Pray for specific areas where group members need God's power.
- Pray for revival in your church, your city, and your generation.
- Pray that wherever you go this week, the power of God would be evident through you.
