### Weekly Memory Verse

### Mixer

### Scripture Reading

Acts 2:42-43, 3:17-18, 4:17-18, 24-26, 29-31; 2 Corinthians 10:3-4

### Sermon Recap & Prayer

In Acts, as the early Church grew in strength, the fire of the Holy Spirit brought on a new way to face crisis and tap into God's power. Having access to that same power ourselves, to have revival in your own life/house, the two weapons you need are prayer and the truth of God's Word.

### Discussion Questions

Observation: What does the passage say?

1. How does **Acts 2:42-43** give us a picture of the forming Church?
2. What was unique about the prayer in **Acts 4:17-18, 24-26 and 29-31**?
3. In **2 Corinthians 10:3-4**, what type of weapons are we encouraged to use, and why?

Interpretation: What does the passage mean?

1. What did you learn about prayer? What does it look like to be devoted in prayer?
2. Who in your life models this hunger for God's Word? What stands out about that person and is it uplifting or judgmental?

Application: How can we apply these passages to our lives?

1. Are there moments in your faith journey when it feels like it has stalled, or you feel like it stopped seeming real? What could be missing?
2. Pastor Jared said that in raising children, parents should "impose your beliefs on your children. It's your job." What prohibits us from imposing our faith on others?
3. A faith that is alive always expresses itself as a hunger for truth. Remember that Pastor Jared has often said that if you don't have faith in Jesus, you are going to have faith in something. Describe a time when you had a hunger for something other than Jesus. How did you realize that this hunger was really fueled by lies disguised as truth?
4. Pastor Jared shared that there comes a time in faith when you realize that the Words *of* God are Words *from* God. Knowing that God has already spoken truth to you about you, what one worldly lie do you still struggle with?
5. What is one thing you can do this week to make faith in Christ your own?

## Huddles

Break into small groups of 3-4 people of the same gender for deeper sharing, accountability, and prayer.

- Pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit on your group.
- Pray for specific areas where group members need God's power.
- Pray for revival in your church, your city, and your generation.
- Pray that wherever you go this week, the power of God would be evident through you.
