Fluency Block Lesson Plan			
Date	Level	Purposeful Fluency-Building Activity	
Group Members Instructional Focus		Prosody Teacher models a dramatic read of the text. Students read the text to one another focusing on pitch, timing, and emphasis. Reader's theater with a chapter of the text, switching tone for characters (reading in character). Pre-read punctuation and read the sentences with the punctuation in mind.	
Word Work	Vocabulary	Repeated Reading Teacher reads the text out loud to the student while the student tracks the text. Student reads the text once silently in their heads.	
Text		Student reads the text once out loud with a focus on accuracy.	
Observations		Student reads the text a second time out loud with a focus on emotion. Accuracy Student scoops text into meaningful phrases as they read aloud Student marks up the text (scooping syllables, identifying phonemes and phonograms, etc.) Teacher marks up the text (scooping syllables, identifying phonemes and phonograms, etc Student reads the marked-up text.
