The meet is held under the latest World Athletics Continental Tour Regulation.

1. Participation Rules

1.1 This meet is open to individual foreign athlete and invited foreign countries.

1.2 The results in this meet can be used for the election of national team.

7. Participants

7.1 Athletes must reach the standard set by CTAA for each event in allowing for participating in this competition.

7.2 Athletes from invited countries.

7.3 Individual foreign athletes please use www.athletics.org.tw to enter the competition.

Please pay the entry fee at the Registration in the lobby of Banqiao Stadium between 14:30-15:30 on 5th June 2026. CTAA only accepts cash in New Taiwan Dollars.

8. Prizes

8.1 The top three places of individual and team events will be awarded medals. Athletes should go to the victory ceremony preparation room right after competition.

8.2 The top eight places of individual and team events will be awarded certificates.

10. Protests

An application to the Jury of Appeal must be submitted by team leader/coach/official/individual athlete within 30 minutes after the official announcement of the result of that event. Each appeal requires a deposit of NT\$3,000, which will be forfeited if the protest is not upheld.

11.1 Technical Meeting will be held in the Audio-Visual classroom right across the lobby in Banqiao Stadium at 15:30, on 5th June 2026

11.3 If athletes wish to use their own equipment (Throwing events), they should send the equipment to Equipment Room of the stadium for certification from 12:00p.m. to 18:00p.m., 6TH-7TH June. The pole should be sent to competition area for certification **60 minutes before** the event.

11.4 Please submit the Relay Line-up Sheet to the competition office (TIC) **90 minutes before** the event. Any late submission will not be accepted.

11.5 Only Official who's on duty and competing athletes will be permitted to enter the competition area.

12. Cancellation of Confirmed Entries

Cancellation of confirmed entries for first day events must be submitted to the Organizing Committee before the end of the technical meeting. Cancellation of confirmed entries for second day events must be submitted to the Organizing Committee before 17:00p.m., 6th June. Athletes who fail to comply will not be allowed to compete in remaining events in accordance with World Athletics Competition Rules.
