VIVA HISTORY

Who we are

VIVA Church, previously known as Oshawa Community Church, started small in 1991, but it hasn't stopped growing since then. We're seeing amazing stories of life change as people come to know Jesus and have a relationship with Him. Our hope is that you will connect with this life-giving community and use your talents to be the hands and feet of Jesus through service. Our desire is for you to grow deeper in your walk with the Lord. Above all, we want to see God's name glorified, not ours. We're the first to admit that we're far from perfect—we're real people, with real problems in need of Jesus. No matter who you are or where you come from, you'll fit right in and together we want to reach people for Jesus.

Where we have been

In August 1992, Pr. Frank moved to Oshawa and pioneered what we know today as VIVA Church. In January 1994, Pr. Frank married Chris and they continued in ministry. Little by little, people began to join them. They moved buildings, added staff and in faith, kept moving forward. Even though there has been much change over the years, the vision remains the same - to reach people for Jesus.

As the years went by, we felt the increasing need to expand beyond Oshawa to impact other cities with the gospel. Soon we found that it would be impossible to plant churches or campuses in other cities with our name as Oshawa Community Church. After much prayer and consideration and with a word from the Lord, on December 6, 2020, we officially became VIVA Church. Our new name enables us to expand to other cities and provinces, and reflect more of who we are as a church in heart and vision.

Where we are going

VIVA Church is continuing to grow and change as a church - adding service times, and hosting city-wide events such as food drive, summer camps, conferences etc. But what will never change is our commitment to doing everything we can to reach people for Jesus.

VIVA STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe the Holy Bible, and only the Bible, is the authoritative Word of God. It alone is the final authority in determining all doctrinal truths. In its original writing, it is inspired, infallible and inerrant.

VIVA ORGANIZATIONAL LEADERSHIP STRUCTURE

The church is a living organism that finds its life and power applied through organization and structure. The style of structure and organization is a flexible issue and may vary greatly from church to church. We have created an organizational model that allows us to function strategically as a team of teams working together with unity and flow.

Defining Terms and Roles

The Lead Pastors: The Overseers of the Vision

The Lead Pastors are the executive overseers of the general vision and direction of the church. The Lead Pastors work within the VIVA Church organizational structure by giving direction to the overall vision and future of the church. The function of the Lead Pastors is to initiate and sustain vision. They have the ultimate responsibility to align the vision with the church's core values, ministry philosophy, principles and general expenditure. The Lead Pastors have the final authority on staffing issues.

The Eldership Team: The Keepers of the Vision

The Eldership Team is accountable for the overall vision, doctrine and major structural changes of the church. The Elders are the spiritual governing body of VIVA Church. The Lead Pastors direct the Elder's meetings and present proposals and topics of discussion. The Eldership Team's responsibilities include discussing and deciding on items such as doctrinal issues, buying or selling buildings or land, structural changes that affect the whole church, confirming new pastors and elders presented by the Lead Pastors, church discipline of a member, church plants etc. Each Elder is responsible to give input through their respective sphere of responsibility and support the overall vision of the church.

The Pastors: The Executors of the Vision

The Pastors work together with the Lead Pastors and the Eldership Team. They are responsible for an assigned number of departments. These duties include implementing the vision in their area of responsibility, encouraging and shepherding the people. They lead different areas of ministries, preach, teach and serve the Lead Pastors and the Eldership Team in anything they need. When called upon, the Pastors meet with the Elders to give input on issues facing the church.

**The Board of Directors:
The Managers of the Vision**

The Board of Directors (BOD) are the only legal members of VIVA Church. They meet yearly to approve the budget and make sure that the finances and the legal aspects of the organization comply with the Canadian government. The BOD works in harmony with the Lead Pastors to ensure that the church functions in a healthy way to maintain its testimony and integrity.

**The Staff and Team Coordinators:
The Implementers of the Vision**

This group consists of those who implement the vision of the church. They receive important communication concerning the vision, structure changes and doctrinal issues prior to the church at large. They serve and support the vision of VIVA Church along with the Lead Pastors, Eldership Team, Pastors and Board of Directors.

PURPOSE OF THE CHURCH

During this lesson we will be focusing on how the church is God's way to supply our need for relationship. We will also be discussing how the church plays an important part in preparing us, in order that we may fulfill His purposes on the earth and meet our need to relate with each other.

**HOW DO
WE GROW?**

1. INVESTING IN OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

To see growth, your personal relationship with God is the first area you need to invest in. God wants you to grow in your spiritual life and there are three areas you need to devote yourself in order to succeed.

1. **PRAYER**

Christianity is more than just a religion. It is a relationship between God and humanity. All relationships grow through communication. The better the communication, the better the relationship will be. Communication is a two-way process involving both talking and listening.

Matthew 6:1-13

2. **WORD**

The Bible is more than an instruction manual or a rule book. It is more than a random collection of stories, poems and letters. It is the voice of God communicating with us. That is why the Bible is often referred to as “the word of God”. King David shows us how we should approach the Bible. David saw God’s word as his source of life and hope. He delighted in it and continually meditated on it. He understood that God spoke to him through it. The bottom line? We know the sound of God’s voice in our lives when we read His word.

3. WORSHIP

Worship is not the slow or the fast song we sing. The types of songs we sing do not define what true worship really is. There are many acts or expressions as well as definitions of worship. One definition characterizes worship as a spiritual discipline. Worship is to honour with extravagant love and extreme submission. True worship is best defined by where God ranks on our list of priorities.

2. SHARING

WHEN DO WE SHARE?

One of our primary purposes is to reach people far from God. Every one of us can do our part by following these four principles:

1. Accept the personal **RESPONSIBILITY**
2. Build a personal **RELATIONSHIP**
3. Share your personal **STORY**
4. Give a personal **INVITATION**

WHERE DO WE SHARE?

In three places:

“You will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

Acts 1:8

1. In Jerusalem - **OUR CITY**

“Real religion, the kind that passes muster before God the Father, is this: Reach out to the homeless and loveless in their plight.” **James 1:27 Message**

2. In Judea and Samaria - OUR NATION

“Whatever a person is like, I try to find common ground with him so that he will let me tell him about Christ and let Christ save him.” *1 Corinthians 9:22 TLB*

3. To the ends of the Earth - OUR WORLD

“Jesus said to His followers, ‘Go everywhere in the world, and tell the Good News to everyone.’” *Mark 16:15 NCV*

At VIVA Church we strategically invest a portion of our resources in mission projects all around the world with a focus on unreached people groups, children and church planting.

HOW CAN YOU JOIN US IN SHARING?

1. PRAYING

Pray for each of these areas that we might reach people with the Good News of Jesus.

“Then he said to His disciples; ‘The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into His harvest field.’” *Matthew 9:37-38*

2. **GOING**

Go to these areas to serve others and show them God's love.

"Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, 'Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?' And I said, 'Here am I. Send me!' He said, 'Go and tell this people...'" *Isaiah 6:8-9*

3. **GIVING**

Give your time and resources to reach people for Christ.

"Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

Matthew 6:19-21

3. PARTICIPATING IN SUNDAY SERVICES

Our Sunday services focus on four values:

1. **CELEBRATION**

We believe church should be enjoyable.

“I was glad when they said to me, ‘Let us go into the house of the Lord.’” *Psalms 122:1 NKJV*

“The kind of worshipers the Father seeks...worship in the Spirit and in truth.” *John 4:23-24*

2. **INSPIRATION**

We believe church should be a place where people experience God’s presence.

“But... when some unbelievers or ordinary people come in, they will be convinced of their sin by what they hear. They will be judged by all they hear, their secret thoughts will be brought into the open, and they will bow down and worship God, confessing, ‘Truly God is here among you!’” *1 Corinthians 14:24-25 GNT*

3. PREPARATION

We believe church should be a place where people learn how the Bible applies to their daily lives.

“So Christ himself gave apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up.”

Ephesians 4:11-12

4. SALVATION

We believe church should be a place where people can accept Jesus as their Lord and Saviour.

“Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. But how can they call on Him to save them unless they believe in Him? And how can they believe in Him if they have never heard about Him? And how can they hear about Him unless someone tells them?” *Romans 10:13-14 NLT*

4. JOINING A VIVA GROUP

A VIVA group is an intentional gathering of people who meet regularly. Since God designed us for relationships, we believe it is through the connections made in small groups that God will help us grow. People form groups around what matters in their lives. This can be by connecting with people who share similar interests or are at the same stage in life, as well as finding people who have experience in an area in which you want to grow. Small groups are also where we pray for each other and support each other. VIVA groups meet regularly in locations all around our region, and with many groups to choose from, we believe there is a group out there for you.

VIVA groups provide three things:

1. A place to CONNECT with others.

“Yes, whatever a person is like, I try to find common ground with him so he will let me tell him about Christ and let Christ save him.” *1 Corinthians 9:22 TLB*

2. A place to PROTECT each other.

“We know what real love is because Jesus gave up His life for us. So we also ought to give up our lives for our brothers and sisters.” *1 John 3:16 NLT*

3. A place to **GROW** together.

“As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another.”

Proverbs 27:17

Two things you should know about our VIVA groups:

Life flows in seasons, and we want to make it easy for you to join a small group. VIVA Groups start and stop three times a year in a cycle we refer to as “seasons.” Each group will vary in length and new groups will be released each season.

1. Each season has **4 MONTHS**

Our seasons are:

SZN1 - January to April

SZN2 - May to August

SZN3 - September to December

2. You can join at **ANYTIME**

5. JOINING GROWTH TRACK

Growth Track is a series of 8-week adult Christian education courses designed to help you grow in your faith and understanding of the Bible. Growth Track is a systematic doctrinal teaching. Courses are offered 3 times per year: fall, winter, and spring. They are held at VIVA Church on Wednesday evenings.

1. Growth Track 01

This course is designed for new Christians and for those who are new to VIVA Church. Get acquainted with your new faith or brush up on the basics. Whether you've been saved one day or 20 years, be prepared to soak in the amazing truths of the Bible.

2. Growth Track 02

This course will establish participants in the foundational teachings of the Christian faith. They obtain a strong understanding of who God is and all that He has accomplished for us. Be prepared for your spiritual roots to go down deep in the truths of the Bible.

We want **YOU** first, then what you can **DO** for VIVA Church.

God has designed His church with the same order that exists in all of His creation. The Bible, particularly the New Testament, gives us specific commandments and principles by which the local church is to operate.

1. God **COUNTS** His people.

- A shepherd counts his flock. **Matthew 18:12; Jeremiah 33:13**
- A good shepherd knows his sheep. **John 10:14**
- A shepherd discerns the state of his flock. **Proverbs 27:23**
- Jesus chose 12 apostles who were named and numbered.
Luke 9:1, 12
- Jesus commissioned a specific 70 to do His work. **Luke 10:1, 2**
- Over 500 witnessed the resurrected Jesus. **1 Corinthians 15:3-8**
- 120 gathered in the upper room on the day of Pentecost. **Acts 1:15**
- 3,000 early church believers were counted. **Acts 2:41**
- About 5,000 were added to the church at one time. **Acts 4:4**
- The number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem.
Acts 6:7

2. The BIBLE refers to records kept of people's names.

- Israelites had their names recorded in the books of genealogy. *Numbers 1, 2*
- The church of the firstborn have their names written in heaven. *Hebrews 12:22-24*
- The redeemed have their names written in the Book of Life. *Philippians 4:3; Revelation 13:8; 21:27*
- The exiles who rebuilt Jerusalem had their names recorded by Nehemiah. *Nehemiah 3:1-32*

3. We are MEMBERS of the Body of Christ.

“For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ. But now God has set the members, each one of them, in the body just as He pleased, that there should be no schism in the body, but that the members should have the same care for one another. And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; or if one member is honoured, all the members rejoice with it. Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually.” *1 Corinthians 12:12*

4. We must belong to a **LOCAL CHURCH.**

- “And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.” **Acts 2:47**
- “And as they went through the cities, they delivered to them the decrees to keep, which were determined by the apostles and elders at Jerusalem. So the churches were strengthened in the faith and increased in number daily.” **Acts 16:4-5**
- “And we urge you, brethren, to recognize those who labor among you, and are over you in the Lord and admonish you, and to esteem them very highly in love for their work’s sake. Be at peace among yourselves.” **1 Thessalonians 5:12-13**
- “Remember those who rule over you, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow, considering the outcome of their conduct.” **Hebrews 13:7**
- “Obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account.”
Hebrews 13:17


Building the church

The concept of a builder is taken from several key passages of scripture:

'Therefore I positioned men behind the lower parts of the wall, at the openings;...Those who built on the wall, and those who carried burdens, loaded themselves so that with one hand they worked at construction, and with the other held a weapon... Every one of the builders had his sword girded at his side as he built. And the one who sounded the trumpet was beside me.'

Nehemiah 4:13-18
