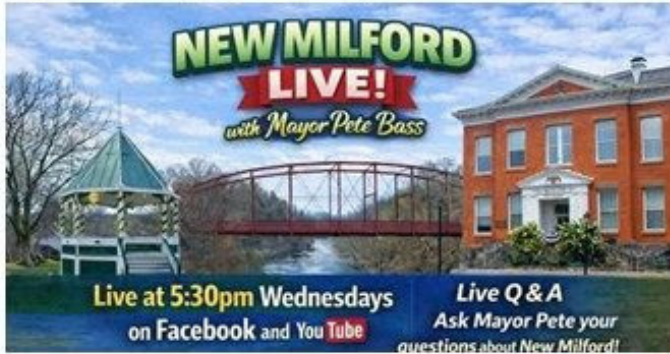

## Roads Update.....

Our DPW crews will be working on the following roads-  
\*\*All crew members will be out monitoring and evaluating conditions of all town owned roadways. Any and all work to clear basin tops, tree debris and any storm damage will be done as deemed necessary. Any and all debris from downed trees will be cleaned up at a later date, opening the roadways is our priority during weather events like this.

(Expect Delays, Obey Road Closures, Watch for Flooding)

Maintenance Crew will be picking up the barricades in the downtown area from the weekend's events. (Expect Delays)

Gravel Road Maintenance Crew will be working on inspecting and cleaning runoffs as needed in the Gaylordsville area. (Expect Delays)

Gravel Road Maintenance Crew will be working on inspecting and repairing road surfaces in the area of Indian Trail and Hine Road. These repairs be performed as needed to make roadways passable. (Expect Delays)  
Tree Crew will be working on storm cleanup in various areas around town. (Expect Delays)

CSR Crew will be working in various areas around town, picking up trash, repairing and/or replacing signs, assisting other crews, and performing any other tasks that are deemed necessary by the town.
