


How to access

- 1 On site? Connect to the IMU University Wi-Fi or use a university computer, then head straight to <u>bestpractice.bmj.com</u> for instant access.
- Off-site or at home? Log in to the <u>IMU Library portal</u>, select Online Databases, then click the BMJ Best Practice link to be redirected to <u>bestpractice.bmj.com</u>.
- 3 Create a BMJ Best Practice account for additional benefits like access to the mobile app and CME/CPD tracking. Simply click 'Your profile', then 'Setup your free user profile', and follow the prompts.

Download the BMJ Best Practice app


- 1. Search for 'BMJ Best Practice' in the App Store or Google Play and download

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

Follow these steps to use

- Click on 'Your Profile' and select
 'Comorbidities Manager' from the list
- Select your chosen acute topic from the list. We are adding more topics to this list all the time, so keep checking back for updates
- 3 Navigate to the 'Treatment algorithm' section of your chosen acute topic. The pink C+ symbol highlights that the Comorbidities Manager is available for this topic
- Select from a list of common comorbidities. You can select as many comorbidities as you like. You will see the pink C+ symbol when a treatment option may be impacted by the comorbidities that have been selected.
