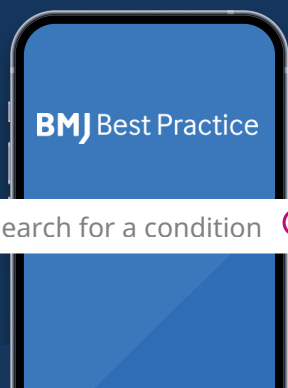
How to access

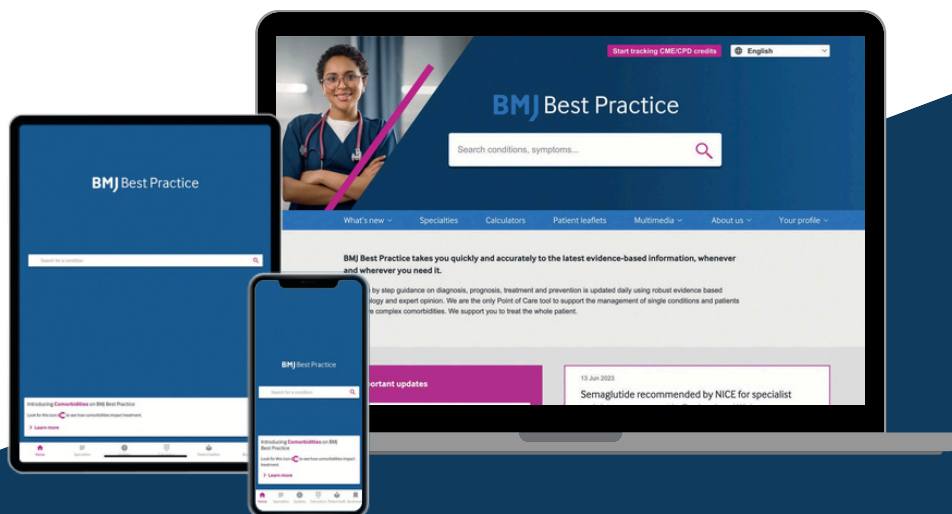
