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NOT REPAIRING MINOR DAMAGE

This is one of the most common mistakes: if hail damage isn't that noticeable on your vehicle, you don't need to get it repaired. People tend to think that if you can't blatantly see the damage, then that damage won't impact your vehicle's value.

This is false.

Even barely visible damage can devastate your vehicle's trade-in value, sometimes dropping it by as much as one-third. That's because **\$3,000-\$8,000 in damage is often** caused even when you can hardly see it.

More serious damage can cause new problems. Windshield cracks, for example, can continue to spread and grow. And serious dents can compromise the integrity of your vehicle's paint, leading to rust and chipping.

Some people are also tempted to fix their hail damage themselves.

Do-it-yourself methods like using hair dryers or dry ice to pop out dents aren't just time-consuming—they usually cause more damage that's not covered by insurance.

Instead, if you want to restore your vehicle to its former glory and protect its value, you're much better off using a professional auto hail repair specialist.

This mistake seems logical. I mean, if you're right in the middle of hail season, why not wait a few more months to get it repaired?

This type of thinking is common. But it can also end up hitting you hard financially. Here are the main reasons why:

A New Storm Means a New Deductible

You need to file a separate claim with your insurance company for each hail storm that damages your vehicle. If you tell your insurer that the damage from both storms was caused by one storm, that constitutes insurance fraud.

Another Storm or Event Can Turn Your 'Repairable' Vehicle into 'Totaled'

Your "repairable vehicle" can quickly turn into "totaled" in the eyes of your insurer if you get hail damage from a second storm. But even if you get into a small accident, such as getting rear-ended at a stoplight, your vehicle can abruptly become classified as "totaled". It's important to keep in mind that insurance companies pay out much less than the market value for your vehicle.

Metal Gets Harder to Shape Over Time

The longer you wait to repair, the less likely your repair will be successful. That's because metal begins to "set" right after it has been deformed. The difference in repair costs 3 weeks after a storm and 3 months later can be substantial.

Another thing holding people back from repairing immediately is the cost. You might be asking yourself questions like, 'How much is this going to set me back?', 'Am I going to have to dig into my savings?' and, 'Is it even worth it?'

What most people don't know is that vehicle hail damage repair can be a lot more affordable than you think.

Here's why:

People living in areas regularly affected by hail won't have to foot the majority of their hail repair bill. If you have comprehensive automotive insurance, you're covered.

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NOT FILING A INSURANCE CLAIM

This common mistake ends up costing people more money every year in lost vehicle value than arguably anything else.

People often wonder if their premium will go up if they file a claim. While this does happen after accidents, hail storms are usually ruled “no-fault” claims. This means that you, as a driver, don’t pose any more risk to the insurance company, so your premiums stay the same.

After a hailstorm, insurance companies will assess the entire area and decide if the whole area should have an increase to their premiums based on the risk of more storms. In those cases, whether people get their vehicles repaired or not - their premium will go up. This is an area risk assessment not a personal risk assessment.

This means that you pay for the benefit of getting your vehicle repaired whether you take advantage of it or not—so you might as well use what you’re already paying for!

How does this work?

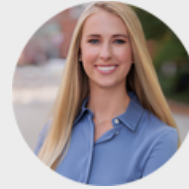
