

Guidance, Growth, and Ongoing Compliance:

A Partnership with Highland Health





Highland Health Providers (Highland), a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC), was established in 2015 to support medically underserved communities in central Ohio. They provide child and adult healthcare and OB/GYN services, and in the nine years they've been operational, they've expanded to support 6 clinics in the practice. Their mission is to serve their community, increasing access to clinics that offer safe, exceptional medical care. In 2022, they decided to build an entity-owned pharmacy to support their expanding capacity and improve community access to medication.

FQHC 340B Offers Highland Expert Entity-Owned Pharmacy Services

Highland brought on Lauren Coor, a highly qualified pharmacist with experience at a major retail pharmacy, to serve as the pharmacy manager and set up the pharmacy. She was given a timeline for building an FQHC 340B-compliant pharmacy from the ground up in 12 months and got to work immediately.

Coor knew that her experience as a pharmacist would help her set up the pharmacy's day-to-day operations, but it was her first time establishing a new pharmacy. To ensure she didn't miss any critical details, she toured other local pharmacies to better understand how they were set up.


She mentioned to the pharmacist at one of these local pharmacies that she was considering hiring a consultant for the compliance-related aspects of establishing an entity-owned pharmacy, and she was told about FQHC 340B Compliance.

Knowing that she and Highland's CFO wanted to find expert support for the licensing, contracting, and compliance aspects of establishing the pharmacy, Coor set up an initial meeting with FQHC 340B Compliance to discuss entityowned pharmacy services.

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That initial meeting has led to an ongoing working relationship that has supported Highland through nearly two years of tremendous growth. This partnership has helped Highland more effectively capture claims and expand capacity, all while remaining fully FQHC 340B compliant.



FQHC 340B Expertise Proves its Worth for Highland

Highland initially planned to work with FQHC 340B Compliance until the pharmacy was up and running and then take over operations internally. However, they found that, even after the pharmacy opened, the added value of FQHC 340B Compliance's expertise and guidance was too valuable to let go. A Surprise Audit Was No Sweat With FQHC 340B Compliance

Within the first four months of business, Highland received its first audit from the Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA). While HRSA audits are, of course, randomized, it was a surprise to receive one this early in operations. However, the timing of the surprise audit was immaterial; Highland was ready from the start in case of an audit.

Highland had established its claim capture processes, contract pharmacy workflows, and overall pharmacy operations within compliance requirements of 340B because of the expert support from FQHC 340B Compliance. They also had immediate support for the audit. When Highland alerted FQHC 340B Compliance that the audit was happening, the response was immediate, and they had expert guidance throughout the process. Highland passed their audit with flying colors and could go through the process more confidently because they knew they were set up for success through their work with FQHC 340B Compliance.

Weekly Meetings With Their 340B Coordinator Keeps Highland Informed

Highland uses FQHC 340B Compliance as its main 340B coordinator and has weekly meetings with them, during which it receives updates and reports on various aspects of its operations. These calls include reporting that goes far beyond the basic numbers.

As 340B Coordinator, FQHC 340B Compliance analyzes and monitors Highland's operational data to inform them each week where they've grown and where (and how) they can improve their metrics. They let Highland know what locations are performing the best and where they may be missing revenue. Highland also receives weekly updates from FQHC 340B Compliance on vendors like their wholesaler, third-party accounts, referrals, and contract pharmacies to prevent surprises for Highland in their working relationships.

These meetings serve as a space for Highland to request help with policies, procedures, and basic organization, as well as to receive updates on 340B compliance requirements. Whether it's questions on verbiage to meet 340B requirements or requests for data and hot points to cover in presentations to the Highland board, FQHC 340B Compliance is ready to provide expert guidance.



Referral Capture Services Support Pharmacy Savings

The consistent support from FQHC 340B Compliance's team helps Coor remain confident in the pharmacy's ability to capture referrals properly and maximize their savings from the 340B program. She doesn't have to second-guess her judgment on a claim because FQHC 340B Compliance has created a custom claim capture process that takes into account patient eligibility using Highland's unique program needs, 340B requirements, State and Federal regulations, and guidance from the Office of Pharmacy Affairs.

FQHC 340B Compliance takes care of the referral process for Highland, assessing prescriptions and tracking down documentation when needed to ensure a claim is complete. Claims are documented and processed each month, and Highland receives monthly reports as well as suggestions for expanding its capacity to capture referrals. FQHC 340B Compliance doesn't simply manage data and provide reports; it helps Highland maximize its benefits by offering them strategic ideas to expand its abilities.

A New Prescription Delivery Service Highlights Highland's Mission

In a rural community, delivery services are often severely lacking, so this unique offering to Highland's patient population has greatly benefited.
