Help prevent fires by properly preparing batteries for pickup.

If battery terminals come in contact with metal or other batteries it can cause sparks, resulting in a fire. Due to safety, if batteries are not properly prepared, we will not take them on pickup day.



- Cover the (+) terminals of each battery using clear packing tape.
 - o DO NOT hide the brand name or chemistry of battery.
 - No Scotch[™] tape (vendor request prone to come off during shipment)
- Larger batteries such as cellphones batteries can go in a clear plastic bag.
 - Only one battery per quart size bag.
- > If batteries are swollen, corroded, leaking, or showing burn marks place them together in a clear plastic bag for easy identification. Keep separate from other batteries.
 - Damaged batteries require special handling.
- > When the batteries have been properly prepared, please place them in your Recycle Plus battery bag for pickup.
