### To Our Lasallian Community,

There was a time, maybe not so long ago, when fathers hoped to pass their work and spirit on to their children. I remember a jewelry store in my old town when I was a kid. It was named Effler's and all of Mr. Effler's sons and daughters worked there. His intent was to hand it off to them. His eldest became a mechanic instead. His other children moved into other occupations. While there may be no actual cause and effect, Effler's is no longer in existence. Farming is another industry that parents typically wanted their children to pursue in their footsteps. But now, large farms are often broken into smaller acreage or have been sold to corporate interests.

St. John Baptist de La Salle was different. He was the one who broke from the family business and from the hierarchy of the Church when he gave up his canonry to serve the young poor boys of Reims who were unsupervised, dirty, and oftentimes thieves. There were young men who joined his teaching community, but many left him. It was a struggle to get his teachers organized and stable. It was so challenging that he and two of his most trusted friends made a vow to be together and to work to see the Society of the Brothers of the Christian Schools established. They would work at it even if they had to live on bread alone.

They succeeded. And now, we are their legacy. What De La Salle and his Brothers started is not just a small community but a movement—a movement to bring the Gospel to life in the world of education. We now call it the Lasallian movement. It is us—you and me and all who have embraced the vision and inspiration that St. De La Salle brought to life in the Church.

We are grateful that OUR Founder has, over more than three centuries, handed down the inspiration behind this movement. The Gospel lives in our schools because we understand that now the work is ours. Together, we can change the lives of the young and lead them to the message of Jesus and the Kingdom of God—God's name is love and the path he gives us is mercy.

Thank you for your contribution to this important work. It cannot succeed without all of us contributing time, talent, and treasure. We are grateful that you have brought your contribution to the table and have become part of the Lasallian movement.

Together, we will continue to create a wonderful future for so many young boys and girls who need the loving care of good faithful teachers and solid faith-based education. De La Salle handed his vision to us. Let us hand it on to future generations.

As different as today's world is from that of St. De La Salle, it is through Formation that the mission is preserved and adapted to meet contemporary challenges. Through it, educators and leaders develop the spiritual, moral, and pedagogical tools needed to continue the Brothers' work and ensure that the Lasallian spirit of education for all, particularly the marginalized, endures.

Just as Lasallian education transforms lives, so does Lasallian Formation. At its heart, it is a journey of discovering the sacred in the everyday—of seeing Christ in the faces of the vulnerable and finding joy in serving others. As the Brothers' numbers decline, Formation remains the most powerful way to sustain our mission, uniting hearts and spirits to ensure that their work continues to shine as a beacon of God's presence in the world.

The power of the Lasallian mission is such that many involved feel "the call"—the need to turn avocation to vocation.

According to Kerry Conroy, Director of Formation for Mission, these members of our Lasallian family are looking for deeper meaning, a vocation greater than themselves.

For these individuals, the wish to follow in the footsteps of St. John Baptist de La Salle, requires further education and training. The Lasallian Formation Program provides that process. It is an effort to be intentional about the development of Lasallian Catholic culture. It is a transformational process that engages the whole person: academically, socially, psychologically, emotionally, and spiritually. And as our Christian Brothers age and retire, the work of Formation is more important than ever.

For Conroy, her call to Formation came via the power of invitation. A colleague saw something in her and invited her into the process. After initial resistance, she could, at her every step, from teacher to counselor to administrator, feel the hand of God at work. She sees her role as that of bringing to people the opportunity, the invitation, to participate in Formation, so that more people can know the extent of their Lasallian mission—the feeling that they are involved in something greater than their own ministry.

Conroy's vision for the Lasallian Formation Program is to create more local options, more realistic opportunities that fit more easily into people's lives. These programs will be focused on the local school and community.

# Lasallian Schools Today



As the Lasallian mission has grown and evolved over the past three centuries, one aspect remains constant—the education of young people.

And over this time, a Christian Brothers education has come to mean more than learning from a book in a classroom. Yes, a Christian Brothers education is rigorous, giving students an academic advantage in preparing for any college, university, or other form of continued education. And it is also practical, giving students the skills necessary to become strong and successful community members. But a Christian Brothers education is more than that. A Lasallian school is a community of learners—part of an educational system and community that spans the globe, allowing students to cultivate a larger, more comprehensive view of the world. It is personal, touching the heart of each student, inspiring them to understand, meet, and surpass their own expectations, to achieve academic success, and to experience personal and spiritual fulfillment in a safe and nurturing environment.

Today, however, there are fewer Christian Brothers in the schools to nurture that environment, and their numbers continue to dwindle. Despite this, the schools have sustained their commitment to the Lasallian mission of student-based, educational excellence. As the number of Christian Brothers has declined in recent decades, their role in Lasallian schools has evolved in profound and meaningful ways. To some, it might seem a lesser role, but rather than diminishing their impact, this transformation has allowed the Brothers to focus their presence on the spiritual and mentoring aspects that lie at the heart of the Lasallian mission. Their daily witness through prayer and contemplation continues to ground our institutions in the sacred purpose that has always defined Lasallian education. The role of the Brothers now manifests through prayer, presence, engagement, and mentoring.

First and foremost, the Brothers' commitment to daily prayer and spiritual reflection maintains the sacred foundation of our mission. Their consistent prayer for our students, employees, institutions, alumni, and all of our Lasallian family, reminds us all that our work is ultimately grounded in faith and service to God's purposes and to each other.

Through their visible presence—attending events, participating in ceremonies, sharing meals, and engaging in daily conversations—the Brothers embody our Lasallian heritage and values. Their presence serves as a living reminder of our history and mission, bringing authenticity and depth to our identity as Lasallian institutions.

One of the hallmarks of the Brothers' educational work is their encouragement of the young. Today, the Brothers offer steady encouragement to faculty, staff, and students as they navigate challenges and opportunities. Their words of support, informed by decades of experience and deep understanding of our mission, help balance perspective, strengthen resolve, and remind us of the meaningful purpose behind our work.

Drawing from their vast experience and deep understanding of Lasallian principles, the Brothers guide and shape new generations of leaders. Through both formal and informal mentoring relationships, they share wisdom, tell stories that illuminate our heritage, and help others discover their role in their communities and in advancing the Lasallian mission.

In the past, the Brothers were the "hands" of the mission, operating schools from administration to teaching. Today, they are its heart.

According to Scott Kier, the superintendent of schools in the district, the reason the schools can continue to embody the mission every day despite there being fewer Brothers is the model of "mission driven governance." This is a commitment of school leadership not only to best practices, but to operating within the mission. Twenty to thirty years ago, the Christian Brothers, understanding the challenges ahead, made a commitment to building school boards, allowing these local boards to take ownership of the schools through hands-on oversight, with the president in the role of chief mission officer. In this model, the role of the district has been to encourage and build boards both through demographics and best practices, while ensuring the maintenance and sustainability of the Lasallian mission.

Within the past five years there has been an infusion of new leadership in district schools, from administration to the faculties, and with it, a re-invigoration of mission. This has been accomplished through the mission-driven model as well as the district's continual work with school boards on formation—developing school leaders who see their role not just as avocation, but as vocation. In this way, with Kier working with the boards and Kerry Conroy, the district's formation director, working with faculty, our schools continue to carry out the Lasallian mission every day.

Lasallian schools, by choice and mission, have always been committed to students of lesser means. As an example of the vibrance of the mission, despite the many challenges that face Catholic schools today, that commitment too, remains strong. In the last school year, 4,524 students, 53.4% of the total students enrolled in the district, received more than \$18M in need-based grants. This is telling, since the average tuition (for those schools that charge tuition) is \$12,100, with a low of \$1,000 and a high of \$18,610. It costs an average of \$16,603 to educate a pupil in a District Lasallian school.

As Lasallian schools continue to adapt to changing educational landscapes, the Brothers' role becomes increasingly critical in maintaining our core identity. Their ability to inspire and connect across generations ensures that the mission transcends institutional structures. By nurturing a deep understanding of Lasallian values among lay colleagues and students, the Brothers create a living legacy that is not dependent on their number, but on the strength of their commitment and the depth of their spiritual vision.

The Brothers' role can be compared to a living bridge between our founding charism and our contemporary mission. Through their encouragement of lay partners and their mentoring of new generations of Lasallian educators, they ensure that the essential character of Lasallian education remains vibrant and true to its origins. Their wisdom and experience provide invaluable guidance as we navigate the challenges of modern education while remaining faithful to our core values and beliefs.

Perhaps most significantly, the Brothers' influence extends far beyond their numbers through the ripple effect of their relationships with faculty, staff, students, and alumni. Their prayers for our community, their encouraging presence, their thoughtful counsel, and their dedication to mentoring future leaders, all multiply their impact throughout our community. In this way, while their numbers may be fewer, their role in sustaining and strengthening the Lasallian mission remains both essential and powerful.

Today, Lasallian schools are well positioned for continued success, despite the many challenges faced by school districts today. An example of how this success is facilitated is the district's work in encouraging partnerships between schools. This has helped to build economies of scale, allowing schools to do things together that they would not have had the wherewithal to do individually. These things can range from greater purchasing power to joint programs for students. In addition, most schools are seeing an increase in enrollment post-pandemic, with a total of 8,472 students at last count.

From mission-driven governance to the building of partnerships and the continued commitment to underserved, underresourced students, the Lasallian family can be confident that, with the prayer, presence, encouragement, and mentoring of the Brothers at their heart, school leadership is not only working at, but succeeding in maintaining and sustaining the Lasallian mission in district schools today.

We ask that you pray for us in our travels, and look for us in your part of the country so that we may see each other again, person-to-person, face-to-face.





#### A Center for Justice

#### **Br. David Darst Center**

The Darst Center's mission is to "provide transformative social justice retreats and immersion experiences grounded in the Lasallian tradition and Catholic Social Teaching." The Center introduces groups to injustice through hands-on experience working in shelters, soup kitchens, inner-city schools, re-entry programs, immigration resource centers, and other local organizations. Its goal is to put a face on those who are poor and marginalized, and to personalize the issues beyond abstract figures and statistics.

Keith Donovan, the Center's director, describes it this way: "I hope that we open the eyes of the folks who attend our programs to see things from new perspectives, to question the status quo, and to imagine both what a different world could look like and how they might be part of building that new vision."

The Darst Center ministry developed in response to the growing need to educate people, especially youth and young adults, about the issues of social justice and to inspire them to be intentional about their own just living.

Br. Denis Murphy, founder of the Center, hoped to create a ministry where the "client" wasn't the person on the margins; rather, the "client" was a high school or college student who often came from more privileged backgrounds and who had little lived experience with urban challenges. The typical retreat group comes to the Darst Center with limited personal exposure to the injustices prevalent in this social context.

As to his vision for the Center, Donovan says, "I hope that the Darst Center can be seen as a place that helps people wrestle with what perpetuates injustice in our communities and gives people the tools and inspiration to consider what they can do to bend the arc of the universe just a little bit more toward justice in their everyday lives."

#### San Miguel School Chicago

"True and sustainable resilience" is the goal at San Miguel School in Chicago's tough Back-of-the-Yards neighborhood, according to Julie Hendry, the school's new executive director. Hendry began her position last September. She was so excited about the mission of San Miguel School Chicago that she moved from Dallas, TX to accept the opportunity. San Miguel is unique in the Chicago area in that it is small, personal, student-centered, and tuition free.

Students at San Miguel School Chicago are provided all the social, emotional, and educational support necessary to successfully achieve what Hendry describes as a sustainable transformation based around the Lasallian charism. The school, which houses a maximum of 75 students grades six through eight, exemplifies the whole-person philosophy of a Christian Brothers education, where children share a sense of belonging, and are known by their names and who they are, and not just as file numbers.

The school provides a Bridge Program to help graduates transition into elite high schools such as Walter Payton College Prep, St. Ignatius, Whitney Young, and our own De La Salle Institute. And the education doesn't stop there. Alums of San Miguel School Chicago are encouraged to come back for tutoring and skill development throughout their high school careers.

Students emulate the Brothers by building people-centered relationships based on care and community. The community is so important that the school also houses a community center which provides classes, such as ESL, exercise, or health for local residents.

So grounded is the Lasallian mission, that the school now staffs six to seven alumni who have come back to share what has been given to them, in true Lasallian fashion.



#### Bringing Healing and Empowerment to Indigenous Peoples

#### De La Salle Blackfeet School

Browning, Montana is home to one of the more unique ministries of the Christian Brothers of the Midwest District. It is the home of De La Salle Blackfeet, the only Lasallian school in the United States with a primary focus on indigenous peoples. The school serves students from 4th through 8th grade, and follows the Christian Brothers' San Miguel model, with a small student body, small class sizes, and extensive support.

The Christian Brothers arrived in Browning 24 years ago at the invitation of the local Little Flower Parish after a failed attempt to open their own Catholic School. And the impact of the school has been tremendous. With the support and education of DLS Blackfeet, students graduate from high school at a rate of 95%. Many Blackfeet graduates go on to success at elite colleges and universities across the country.

To bring awareness to the challenges faced by indigenous peoples, DLS Blackfeet runs a week-long immersion program, attended by representatives of Lasallian schools from all over the country. After Mass and orientation, participants are assigned grade levels for which they work during the week. They also learn of things such as indigenous land use and meet with local community members.

De La Salle Blackfeet hopes to bring visibility to an invisible community and to combat the social injustices that this community faces. As Jon Ficaro, the school's Immersion Program Director and Director of Development says, "As Catholics, we are our brother's keeper; it is our responsibility to accompany this community in their process of healing from injustices of the past, and to empower them to shape their future."

#### A Symbol of Tradition and Unity

#### St. George High School

The St. George High School Alumni Association remains vital to this day because of the work of Br. Luke Clement, who formed the Association, and then Br. Peter Donlan, who inherited it and built it into a strong, stable organization. A symbol of this strength and the alumni's continued dedication to the Christian Brothers and the mission of education, is the Burnell Tuition Assistance Program, or "TAP."

TAP has been in operation now for 25 years and has provided over \$208,000 in scholarship funds to students at St. Patrick High School. The Association began the program as a way to show appreciation for the influence of the Christian Brothers on students' lives. Through other activities, the Alumni Association also raises funds for the care of senior Brothers.

St. George was characterized by the personal involvement of the Christian Brothers. The ability to speak to a Brother, before school, after school, during extra-curricular periods, man to man, was important to the development of St. George students. Through the dedication of the Christian Brothers, a young man could learn from the experiences and perspectives of an older, more experienced man freely, without constraint, and without fear for confidentiality. But not only could a student approach one of the Brothers; oftentimes, a Brother or another staff member would approach students with concerns about their wellbeing.

#### The Spirit and Camaraderie of the Knights Lives On

#### St. Mel High School

St. Mel High School opened on the west side of Chicago in 1918. It was a parish school named for one of two brothers (both saints!), who were nephews of Saint Patrick. Over time, St. Mel became well-known throughout the city, and developed a tradition of scholarship, action, and dedication to its Catholic, Lasallian mission. Its combination of training in religious, academic, and cultural disciplines with its military and physical education programs, made it one of the premier schools in Chicago. In addition to rigorous academics, outside the classroom there were a number of after school activities where students had the chance to interact with each other. And the Christian Brothers were there to facilitate and develop this growth and change.

Alumnus Pat Savage recalls that St. Mel was a school that fostered togetherness—it was a school where you could "get to know people" and that togetherness was what made St. Mel a special place. In addition, as a long-time teacher himself, Pat sees the value in the education he received at St. Mel, as well as in Catholic education today, where students are taught to high standards and a higher level of care.

Despite having been closed since 1970, the St. Mel Alumni Association remains strong, with alums motivated by the Lasallian experience and an appreciation for the teachers who helped make them into who they are today. St. Mel reunions are important today because they offer more than a chance to reconnect with old classmates—they provide a moment to reflect on life's journey and remember an important time in the unique environment of a Christian Brothers school. They remind us of who we once were, to share and celebrate who we have become, and often help us understand how our Lasallian experience shaped our paths.
