

Where Ministry Lives

An altar is where the ordinary becomes sacred—where the everyday encounter becomes divine presence. For Lasallian educators, the classroom holds the same transformative power.

When we speak of “the classroom as an altar,” we’re not using metaphor for decoration. We’re naming what happens when teachers show up fully present to their students, when learning becomes an act of faith, when education stops being transaction and becomes vocation. Teaching as lived ministry means every student interaction is a sacred encounter.

But “classroom as altar” is not confined to a school or a building. Wherever our Lasallian family meets needs, sacred space emerges. In hospitals and care centers, in distant lands or our own communities, Lasallians bring the spirit of ministry to everyday life. Formation programs, retreats, care for senior Brothers—these, too, become sacred space. “Classroom as altar” is about ministry lived daily, wherever we are called to serve.

The four reflections that follow take us from Cincinnati to Memphis, from Minnesota to Singapore—different communities, different contexts, but the same recognition: that education becomes ministry when we meet students where they are and walk with them toward who they are becoming. Whether through international immersion, cultural exchange, formation programming, or the daily rhythms of Lasallian school life, these leaders witness to what happens when we treat our classrooms as sacred space.

In each program, you’ll see educators choosing presence over efficiency, relationship over curriculum, transformation over information. You’ll see lived ministry at work—where every student carries the holy, and every moment of genuine encounter is a chance to honor it.

This is what it means to teach as St. John Baptist de La Salle taught: to see Christ in every student, and to let that vision change everything.

Br. Lawrence Humphrey is the Brother President of St. Joseph's Institution International in Singapore.

If you knew then what you know now, would you do it all over again? Most of us probably ask ourselves this question at one time or another, perhaps more so the older we get. As I reflect on my 50+ years of service, there are just a handful of days that I would “do over” if given the chance.

I remember a senior Brother assuring us then young Brothers of the hundred-fold reward Jesus promises to Peter (Mark 10:30), to be given to those who sacrifice for Jesus' sake and the gospel; actually, two rewards, one in this life and one in eternal life. He assured us we would find the earthly portion of our reward in two places, the community and the classroom. Brother Erminus was spot on.

For me it's been a lifetime of rewarding ministry, from Memphis to Paducah, to Kansas City, to Tulsa, St. Louis, Winona, and for the past 12 years, in the Lasallian East Asia District at our international school in Singapore. In most cases, I was “in the right place at the right time.” This was true for me, and hopefully for the students and staff of the schools where I've been privileged to serve.

I believe that working with young people keeps you young— if not physically, at least in your outlook and thinking. While the time and places may change, young people always have a way of making our best efforts worthwhile. The students in Singapore, from time to time, ask me, “How are we different from your students in the United States?” They are surprised when I tell them, “You are much more alike than you are different.” That's probably why I think my ultimate reflection is one of hope.

In every age, young people hold the promise of the future. Our hopes and dreams for the future are ultimately entrusted to them.

I have been rewarded in so many ways to witness the transformative power of Catholic and Lasallian education, not only in the lives of former students, but also in the lives of younger teachers I've been honored to mentor and support throughout the years. To see the wonderful “grown-ups” they have become, raising children of their own, with a few of them even becoming teachers, has been a special joy.

A few years ago, a special group of my former students came together for a unique and special reunion. From across the country, they returned to the same classroom, outside of Paducah, Kentucky, where decades earlier we had explored world cultures. While reminiscing of those happy days at

Saint Mary High School, I can still hear one of them saying, "We loved the Brothers!" Heartfelt and genuine. My immediate response was, "And we loved all of you, too." It was one of those 'touching hearts' moments that St. John Baptist de La Salle wrote about.

That promised reward of eternal life always seemed like something "out there," but the older I get it takes on more meaning for me. In his 16th Meditation written for the Brothers for the time of their annual retreat (The reward that a Brother of the Christian Schools ought to expect in heaven if he is faithful to his work), De La Salle writes about the happy heavenly reunion between a Brother and his students:

"Oh, what joy a Brother of the Christian Schools will have when he sees a great number of his students in possession of eternal happiness, for which they are indebted to him by the grace of Jesus Christ! What a sharing of joy there will be between the teacher and his disciples! What a special union with one another there will be in the presence of God! It will be for them a great satisfaction, sharing together the blessings for which the call of God had given them hope, the wealth of the glorious heritage of God in the dwelling of the saints." (208.2)

The thought of such a reunion once seemed far off, even obscure. From time to time, however, I find myself looking forward to that reunion. But not just yet!

For more than a decade, Christian Brothers High School in Memphis, Tennessee and its Lasallian counterpart, Colegio LaSalle, in San Jose, Costa Rica have shared a bond beyond geography. Each year, students from both schools participate in the Brothers Around the World exchange program that immerses them in one another's cultures, communities, and classrooms. Both schools have partnered with St. Agnes Academy, also in Memphis, to include girls in the program. What begins as a travel experience quickly becomes a journey of faith, service, and brotherhood—a living expression of the Lasallian mission.

After a pause during the challenges of the pandemic, the exchange program resumed its full strength, welcoming groups of young men and women eager to learn and serve. Christian Brothers High School students were warmly received in Costa Rica, where they lived with host families, attended classes at Colegio LaSalle, and engaged in cultural activities that revealed the beauty of Lasallian education in a different setting. Likewise, the Memphis community opened its homes and hearts to

visiting Lasallian students, who experienced Southern hospitality and the shared values that define our Lasallian heritage—faith in God's presence, respect for all persons, and commitment to community.

The program offers much more than sightseeing or language immersion. It invites students to recognize that Lasallian education transcends borders.

Whether in San Jose or Memphis, students discover their peers face similar joys and challenges yet are united by the same call to live with integrity, serve others, and lead lives of faith. Teachers and administrators, too, benefit from this partnership—sharing best practices, learning about new approaches to student formation, and strengthening the global Lasallian network.

The friendships formed through the exchange endure beyond the weeks of travel. Students return home with a broader worldview, deeper empathy, and renewed enthusiasm for the Lasallian mission. Their stories remind us that our shared ministry to “touch hearts and transform lives” continues to flourish across nations.

Together, Christian Brothers High School and Colegio LaSalle are building bridges of understanding, one student, one family, and one Lasallian relationship at a time, serving as altars of service and gratitude far beyond the walls of a classroom.

At Holy Family, the concept of the classroom as an altar is embodied daily in the relationships we cultivate and the intentions we bring to every encounter with students, faculty, staff, parents, and community members. As affirmed by Pope Leo XIV, teaching here is not simply a profession but a true vocation: each day, we are called to serve, uplift, and inspire those entrusted to our care. This belief comes to life every day through the spirit of our Holy Family FIRE Way: Grow, Seek God, Love One Another, Do the Right Thing, Recognize and Share your Gifts, and Be a Part of the Community. All students at the school participate in FIRE Way groups. It is our response to the Holy Father's question, “What values are to be promoted?”

The FIRE Way imperatives were developed by faculty, staff, and students. They are intentionally woven into academic and campus life. As a school community, we participate in an annual FIRE Way retreat and monthly convocations focused on an imperative. We also gather monthly in our FIRE Way small groups, each belonging to a house named after one of the imperatives, to build community and deepen our shared

Chris Winiarski is the Director of Campus Ministry, Mission and Formation at La Salle High School in Cincinnati, Ohio, where he also teaches Religion.

Ideas don't change people—God-centered relationships do. While much of modern education centers on knowledge and ideas, Lasallian education holds that transformative education happens through relationships rooted in truth and love, freely given by our wise and loving God. For us as Lasallians, knowledge and wisdom go hand in hand, and are found most readily in the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, which animates our teaching and learning.

In his May 15, 2025 address to the Brothers of the Christian Schools, Pope Leo XIV reminded us that our teaching as Lasallian educators is "more than pedagogy; Lasallian education is ministry and mission, a consecration in the Church." Our classrooms, therefore, are not confined by four walls—they are the locus of sacred encounter, formation, and service with and for the students entrusted to our care. Lasallian educators lead and accompany young people to discover that their true identity is grounded in God's eternal love and that their purpose is to live out that love in Gospel-centered relationships.

values. Students remain in the same multi-grade groups throughout all four years, along with faculty and staff. All of the initiatives are developed and led by our FIRE Way student leaders. Lastly, we recognize students who are living out the FIRE Way in our monthly awards ceremony.

In encouraging students to "Grow" and "Seek God," we foster an environment where spiritual formation and intellectual curiosity flourish side by side.

"Love One Another" and "Do the Right Thing" guide our actions and interactions. By helping each person to "Recognize and Share your Gifts," we acknowledge their unique contributions. "Be a Part of the Community" is more than an invitation—it is a profound commitment to ensure that each person feels they are known, named, and loved for who they are.

This approach, grounded in our mission, has transformed the routine of school life into a series of sacred encounters that reach beyond academics. Each day at Holy Family affirms the principle that every action can "touch the hearts" of young people and empower them to live courageously and generously according to God's plans. Every classroom becomes an altar—a place where students, teachers, and staff are called to give the best of themselves in the service of God and one another.

LA SALLE HIGH SCHOOL | CINCINNATI, OH

As a Christian Brother's boy myself, I know firsthand the transformative power of a Lasallian education. Now, as a Lasallian educator at La Salle High School in Cincinnati, I am privileged to witness God's grace unfold daily in the lives of our students, staff, and families. One father recently shared a powerful reflection after attending a freshman retreat here at La Salle High School with his son Eric. This retreat is focused on faith, service, and community. He wrote of serving together with his son at the local St. Vincent de Paul food pantry, where they met Ms. Lisa, a mother shopping for her large family:

"After morning prayer at La Salle, we left for our morning of volunteer service together at St. Vincent de Paul. We were helping our neighbors in need, when we helped Ms. Lisa, a mother of eight. During our time together Ms. Lisa suffered a panic attack, fell to her knees, and shared that she hadn't slept or eaten much recently. After a few minutes, when we finally were able to calm her down some, she revealed through her tears that her son had been murdered just a week earlier. I didn't know what to do, except ask her at that moment if she needed a hug? She collapsed into my arms, weeping. In her pain and vulnerability, she opened her heart to us, sharing her story of loss, love, and perseverance. I shared with her that I was there on a retreat with my son Eric, and she looked at us and through her sorrow filled eyes she urged us to tell each other 'I love you' every day—not just through actions, but in words.

We later accompanied her to her car, assisted her and shared in meeting her mom. As a father and son, we will not soon forget that powerful experience with Ms. Lisa and her mom. If that encounter wasn't enough, we returned to La Salle for Mass, directly followed by a powerful witness talk focused on the importance of our father-son relationship. This talk helped to confirm for me that none of this was coincidence. God placed us there for Ms. Lisa, and her for us. It truly was a profound day that we won't forget."

In every Lasallian classroom—whether a theology classroom, a football field, a theater, or, yes even a food pantry—the sacred ministry of Lasallian education unfolds. It is there that intellect and spirit converge, and the Good News of Jesus Christ emerges from the God-centered relationship which gives us a new way of being, thinking and living. For us Lasallians, it is not just what we teach or where we teach that matters most—but how we teach the young people entrusted to our care.

In short, our Lasallian classrooms are holy ground, where relationships focused on divine union give way to transformation, where students realize their full potential of body, mind, and spirit.

The Ministry of Presence

Throughout the year, we gather as a Lasallian community—around tables, at events, during celebrations, and in times of need. In each other’s presence, we reaffirm that every person’s well-being is sacred. Traveling to communities near and far reminds us we are part of a shared, expansive mission that is larger than ourselves.

Every gathering is an opportunity for relationships to deepen and our ministry to be sustained. We see this at reunions, where classmates ensure everyone can attend regardless of mobility or finances, and at Lasallian conferences, when we return energized by greater connection with our larger Lasallian community. We witness it in personal visits where our benefactors show their compassion and care. Travel becomes a form of pilgrimage, a journey toward deeper understanding of each other and our collective purpose—a tangible presence that embodies our core belief: relationships are not maintained from a distance; they require us to show up.

Our commitment to relationship and ministry is also evident in our care for the Christian Brothers who spent their lives in service. Together, we remain in community, with the community, supporting one another across generations.

In every shared journey, every meal, and every moment of care given and received, we live the truth at the heart of our mission: relationship is sacred.

This year’s gatherings, travels, and celebrations were essential work of tending to the authentic community where teaching and ministry thrive.

District Days

Where Ministry Becomes Sacred Space

“District Days” is a 48-hour period that Brothers set aside to discuss matters important to them, and to celebrate jubilee years and newly taken or renewed vows. But District Days is more than that: it transforms gathering into grace. When Christian Brothers convene to explore the issues that mean the most to them, they create “sacred space”—not through ritual, but through radical presence.

The late Pope Francis’s call to be “attentively present, engaged with, and responsive to” the world resonates deeply with these gatherings. As Francis wrote, true wisdom requires being “skillfully attuned” to daily life—in classrooms, offices, communities—responding to each person as “a special aspect and particular path to fuller life.”

The Brothers take seriously Pope Francis’s call to “decenter and transcend.” To do so is to move beyond self-interest toward genuine partnership. Engagement awakens a moral awareness: not only do we need each other, but we have a responsibility for one another. District Days calls Brothers to attentive engagement—not an abstract theology, but the practical recognition that we need each other.

In the Lasallian community, every setting becomes sacred through presence, listening, and teaching by example. When Brothers gather, they model what all educators seek: communities where celebration and serious discernment coexist, where service is honored, and where engagement draws everyone more fully into life.





The Saint Yon Society, the giving community of the Christian Brothers of the Midwest, is named after the location of an early school and boarding house founded by Saint John Baptist de La Salle. Often referred to as the birthplace of the Institute, Saint Yon was a place for the Brothers to build their fraternal bonds and commit to the mission we know of today. Saint Yon held a special place in the heart of our Founder. It is at this location, surrounded by the Brothers he brought together, where he entered into eternal life.

The Saint Yon Society is the primary support of the Christian Brothers of the Midwest and ensures the care of our senior Brothers and the continued high-quality leadership in Lasallian Education. Members support the recruitment of Vocations for our next generation of Brothers, increase the transformative power of a Lasallian Education through Formation programming, and provide prayerful support through the intercession of Saint John Baptist de La Salle.

Sister Louise of Parmenie



Sr. Louise Hours was born in Le Touvet, near Grenoble, France, in 1646. Her family moved to Parmenie in 1648, where she grew up looking after the sheep on her family's land.

In the early 1670s, Sr. Louise felt called to restore the ruined chapel on Mount Parmenie. Her vision was simple yet profound: to create a space where weary souls could find rest and renewal in God's presence. She rebuilt the chapel with help from others, and it was blessed in May of 1674.

Nearly forty years later, St. John Baptist de La Salle came to Parmenie after suffering a serious illness. It was also a time of deep discouragement and uncertainty about the future of his mission. Here he met Sr. Louise, whose faith, counsel, and commitment to discerning God's will offered him clarity and strength. Her steadfast encouragement helped De La Salle regain confidence in his vocation and return to guide the Brothers—ensuring the survival of the Christian Brothers and their mission.

The encounter at Parmenie between De La Salle and Sister Louise in 1714 is perhaps the most important event that ever took place there. There is good reason to suppose that if this providential encounter had not taken place, De La Salle's work might have perished.

Her legacy continues to inspire, reminding us that following God's will often requires courage, faith, and the willingness to navigate uncertainty. Sister Louise was 82 when she died on January 22, 1727, having spent 54 years at Parmenie, where she is buried in the crypt of the chapel she helped to restore.

Adrien Nyel and The Encounter



Adrien Nyel was a zealous, energetic layman and educator who worked in Rouen, France, for many years establishing schools for the poor. He was asked by a wealthy widow, Madame Jeanne Dubois Maillefer, to consider founding a charity school for boys in Reims. The first thing he did in Reims was to seek guidance and support from the Sisters of the Holy Child of Jesus. At the entry of the convent, he was introduced to the young canon of the Cathedral at Reims, Fr. John Baptist de La Salle.

As a result of this chance encounter, De La Salle offered to use his connections and resources to help Nyel establish a school as well as recruit and train teachers. Initially, De La Salle saw helping Nyel as just another act of charity. But his involvement deepened. De La Salle found himself drawn into an unfamiliar world—the world of the poor—a world of disadvantaged students, teachers who lacked purpose, and families oppressed by poverty. He responded by forming those teachers into a community with a shared spiritual and professional life, a community that eventually became the Brothers of the Christian Schools. Around 1682, the formal collaboration between the two men ended.

Adrien Nyel planted a seed by opening schools, and St. John Baptist de La Salle cultivated and nurtured that seed into a strong, enduring tree—the worldwide network of Lasallian schools that exists today. Nyel is the pioneer and catalyst who brought the practical work of charity schools to De La Salle's doorstep. Without him, the De La Salle story might have been vastly different.

THE GIFT OF PROVIDENCE

Adrien Nyel's encounter with De La Salle was an act of providence—a moment when possibility met response, and a mission was set in motion. His role reminds us that God often works through timely openings and willing partners. Today, gifts given in that same spirit of trust help keep the Lasallian mission strong, ensuring that what began in faith continues in stability and service for generations.





Living the Lasallian Mission: The Servant Leader Experience at Dunrovin Retreat Center

At Dunrovin Retreat Center, the Servant Leader Team—known as LEAD Immersion—brings the Lasallian principle of education as lived ministry to life. Over an eleven-month commitment, young adults dedicate themselves to learning, serving, and growing in faith through a unique blend of retreat ministry, community life, and hands-on leadership training.

Every day becomes both classroom and chapel. Team members guide youth retreats, offering hospitality, reflection, and witness. Under the mentorship of experienced leaders, they gain essential career and life skills—communication, stewardship, teamwork, and financial responsibility—all seen through the lens of service. Workshops on practical skills like cooking, budgeting, and collaboration help participants see that ministry extends far beyond the retreat center: it takes shape in daily acts of service, responsibility, and respect for others.

The program's heart is spiritual formation. Through prayer, shared reflection, and one-on-one faith coaching, participants discover that their growth is itself a ministry. They learn to see God's presence in every task, from leading a retreat to setting the table, from mentoring a student to managing time wisely.

At Dunrovin, education is not just preparation for life—it is life. In the Servant Leader Team, ministry is not confined to worship or teaching but lived daily, transforming ordinary work into a sacred act of love and service.

Forming Missionary Disciples: Instituto Fe y Vida

Instituto Fe y Vida is a Lasallian ministry dedicated to forming missionary disciples—young people, families, and pastoral leaders. Rooted in the charism of St. John Baptist de La Salle, Fe y Vida understands formation not simply as instruction or lessons, but as experiences and accompaniment: walking alongside our people as they discover faith, purpose, and belonging.

Over the past three decades, Fe y Vida has formed more than 13,000 leaders through programs that integrate faith, culture, and service. Ministries include leadership formation for youth and young adults in parishes and dioceses, family formation programs such as Thriving Catholic Parishes and Amor y Vida, and a biblical ministry that publishes the *Biblia Católica para Jóvenes* in Spanish, Portuguese, and Italian. Through these initiatives, Instituto Fe y Vida serves Latino communities across the United States, Latin America, and Germany.

In preparation for the Jubilee Year 2025, Fe y Vida worked closely with Br. Juan Manuel Hernández Bernal, FSC, and the Lasallian Brothers at the Casa Generalizia in Rome, organizing four impactful Jubilee experiences for teens, young adults, catechists, and migrant families. Each Jubilee pilgrimage began with online formation sessions that included one on St. John Baptist de La Salle and the Lasallian charism, and culminated in sacred journeys to Rome and Assisi, where the Christian Brothers welcomed us as family. The Migrant Jubilee, which included two Christian Brothers as pilgrims, concluded with a private Papal Audience—an unforgettable encounter of faith, grace, and hope.

Nursing staff who care for our senior Brothers gathered for a retreat grounded in the Brothers' tradition: education as lived ministry.


