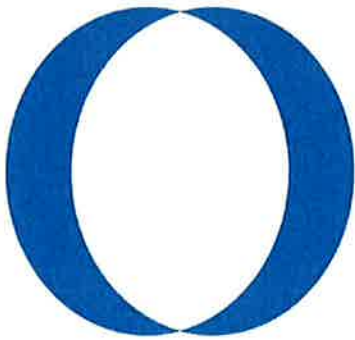

Policy for the Prevention of Serious Accidents

The Management of BONDALTI, aware of its environmental legal obligations and within the scope of Major Accident Prevention, has established this Policy for the industrial establishment of Bondalti Chemicals|Portugal and Bondalti Cantabria|Spain. This policy is aligned with the QAS Policy defined for BONDALTI.



Commitment



Assuming its commitment to carrying out all necessary actions for the implementation of this policy, BONDALTI has developed, implemented, and will maintain in the said facilities a Safety Management System for the Prevention of Major Accidents (SGSPAG), supported by the Integrated Management System (SGI), which:

1. Describe the roles and responsibilities of the people involved in safety management, including subcontractors.
2. Identifies, assesses, and manages risks inherent to the activities, in order to prevent serious accidents from occurring.
3. Develops and implements operational procedures in order to achieve high levels of operational performance.
4. Define goals, objectives for controlling major accident risks, safety and environmental activities, monitoring performance regarding their fulfilment.
5. Ensure that changes are made based on a structured method, minimizing the risks associated with this process.
6. Establishes the emergency response to situations that put the facilities, their workers, and nearby populations at risk, in order to reduce their effects.
7. Promotes training and education as a way to raise awareness and encourage continuous improvement in performance, in controlling the risks of serious accidents.
8. Promotes the conduct of systematic audits on the level of implementation of the Safety Management System for the Prevention of Serious Accidents.
9. Provides for the evaluation of the Safety Management System for the Prevention of Major Accidents.

Thus, the management of BONDALTI is committed to providing the appropriate means (material, human, technological, and financial) and structures to promote the continuous improvement of the Serious Accident Prevention Management System in accordance with the legislation in force in this area, and to ensure compliance with the principles of Responsible Care, as well as to permanently improve the control of serious accident risks and guarantee a high level of protection.
