

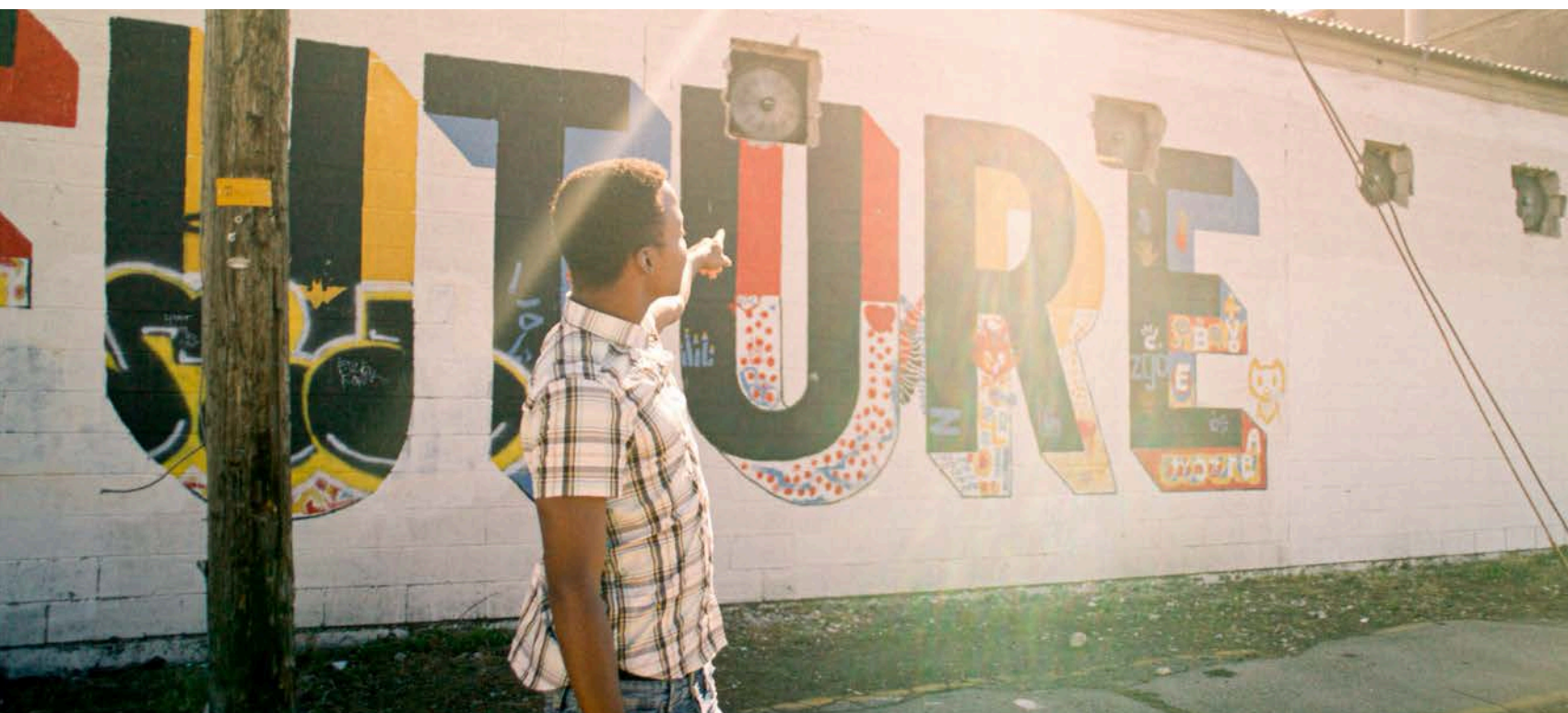


Serving homeless and at-risk youth ages 15-22

Our Work and Impact

VOA Utah's Youth Resource Center is a comprehensive resource center and emergency shelter in Salt Lake City for youth, ages 15-22, who are at imminent-risk-of or experiencing homelessness. In operation since 1999, the YRC transforms the lives of youth experiencing homelessness by providing a continuum of evidence-based, wraparound services: from emergency shelter and hot meals to housing case management and legal services. The program's daily operations are accomplished by a dedicated professional team of 32 full and part-time employees and its facilities are staffed 24/7, 365 days a year.

Eligibility and Enrollment

Clients must be ages 15-22 who are at imminent-risk-of or experiencing homelessness. Arrive at our resource center located at 888 South 400 West in Salt Lake City and a front desk staff will assist you. For more information, call 801-364-0744.

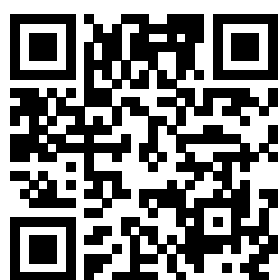
