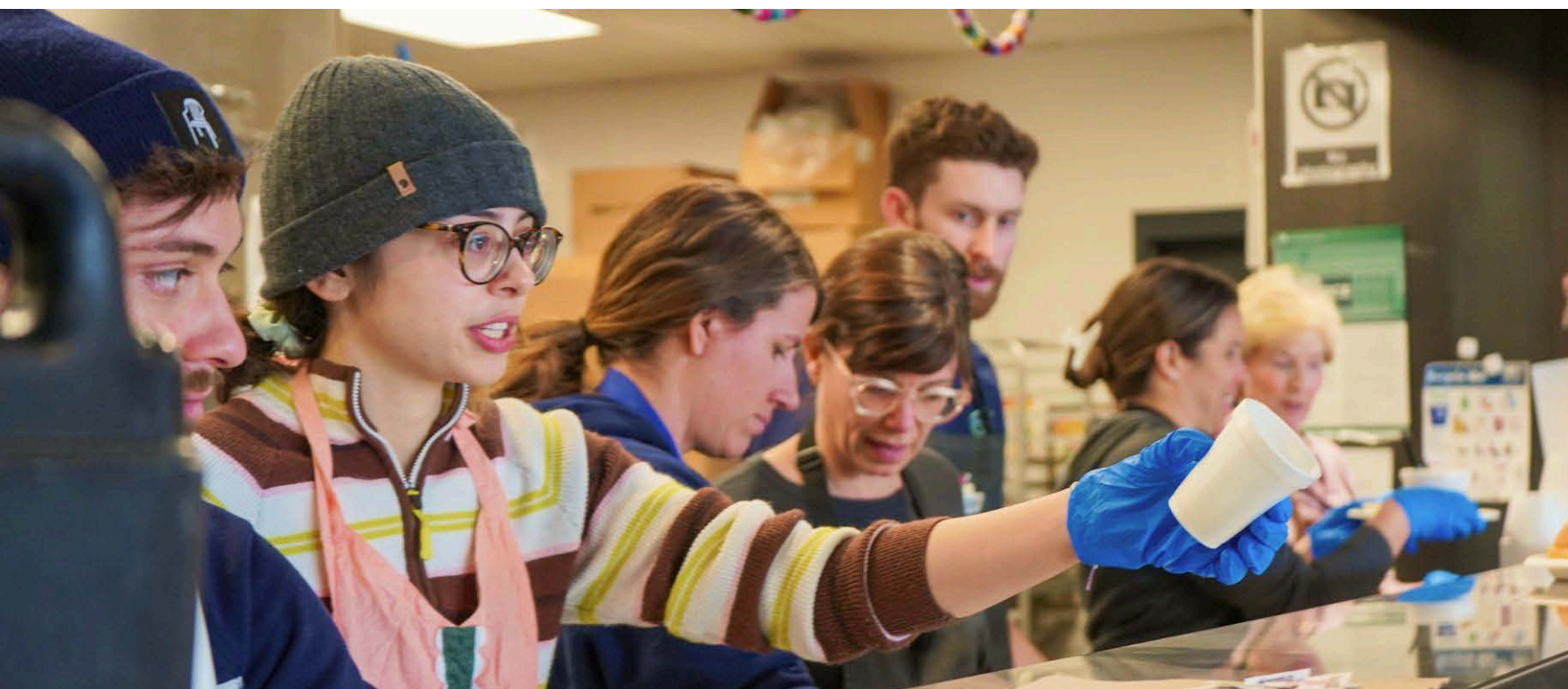

# Our Work and Impact

The WRC provides emergency shelter to 200 women (250 from mid November to Mid April) experiencing homelessness in the Salt Lake area, twenty-four hours a day, 365 days a year. Clients receive basic needs like meals, clothing, hygiene items, washing facilities, and more. Along with basic necessities, WRC clients also receive case management support from staff members who help women ages 18 and older find stability and get back on a path toward flourishing and self-sufficiency.

## Eligibility and Enrollment

Women, 18 years or older, that are experiencing homelessness in Salt Lake City may access emergency shelter at the Geraldine E. King Women's Resource Center. Call the Homeless Connections Hotline at 801-990-9999 for bed availability. Or inquire about availability in person at 131 E 700 S, or at the Weigand Center at 437 W 200 S.

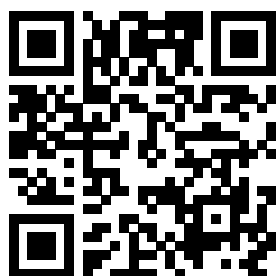
