Movement of pigs from a farm for breeding, exhibition, artificial insemination, or veterinary treatment: the pigs (records, identification, and movement) Order 1995.

Exhibitors bringing pigs to the 2026 Stithians Agricultural Show will need to complete a declaration relating to their movement in accordance with the above Order. On return the pigs must be kept separate from all other pigs for a minimum of 21 days.

Licensing & Documentation: Please ensure all pigs have the correct movement licence in place. Movements will have to be reported either using the free eAML2 online service or the free eANML2 bureau service. Full details can be found on the Defra website regarding the rules regulating the transporting of livestock. Defra Website: www.defra.gov.uk/food-farm/animals/welfare/transport

Pigs may arrive between the following times. Saturday 11th July 2026 & Sunday 12th July 2026 between the hours of 10am and 9pm, and again from 5am Monday 14th July 2026 via prior arrangement with the Pig Section Secretary. All animals must be within the showground by 8am on show day 13th July 2026. The above deadlines must be adhered to by all pig exhibitors. If this is not the case Exhibitor's run the risk of not being permitted to exhibit. All pigs must remain until 6.00pm unless by special circumstance and with the Section Secretary approval.

Passes The following passes will be allocated to the pig exhibitors, any additional passes required please contact the section secretary at pigs@stithians.show under Five entries 2 one day passes, six to ten entries 3 one day passes, over ten entries 4 passes.

Exhibitors may make a maximum of three entries in any one class. All Exhibitors must display the correct showing number for each class. Additional rosettes and prize cards will be awarded in the pig classes as follows: 6th rosette in classes with over eight entries. 7th rosette in classes with over 10 entries.

Animals entered in these classes will not take part in the Grand Parade of Livestock.

Breed judging will take place on Monday 13th July 2026 commencing at 9.00am.

Disclaimer

I Understand that it is a condition of entry that all details of entries will be shared with any relevant bodies, that names and addresses will be printed in the catalogue and results displayed on the Association's web site. Entry Fee: All Classes £8.00 to include penning fee. Pens are for pigs only there will be a separate area provided as kit pens. Water and bedding will be supplied. Young Handler £3.50.

Rules and Regulations

1. Pigs to have been registered in a published volume or accepted for entry in a forthcoming volume of the British Pig Association's Herd Book or the British Lop Pig Society's Herd Book.
2. The ear number, registered name, Herd Book number and date of birth of each pig, also the Name and Herd Book number of the sire and dam must be supplied for printing in the catalogue, together with the name of the breeder in cases where the exhibitor is not also, the breeder.

FAILURE TO SUPPLY FULL INFORMATION WILL RESULT IN YOUR ENTRY BEING RETURNED.

3. At all Shows in 2026, female pigs (all breeds) born before 1 January 2025 shall be eligible to compete only if in the six calendar months prior to the Show they have farrowed, suckled and reared to four weeks of age, a birth notified litter of pigs.
4. At all Shows in 2026, female pigs born on or after 1st January and before 1st July in the year before the show must within 18 months of their date of birth have farrowed, suckled and reared to four weeks of age, a birth notified litter of pigs.
5. All boars must be shown by two competent (over 16yrs of age) handlers who are equipped with protective boards. Anyone deemed not competent by the judge may be asked to leave the ring.
6. The use of artificial colouring, whitening and/or powder on pigs as well as the removal or addition of spots by artificial means is prohibited (white wood flour is permitted)
- 7 Stithians Show can offer any exhibitor free camping to those wishing to arrive on the Saturday 11th & Sunday 12th July 2026 (*if wishing to camp please make a note on entry form)

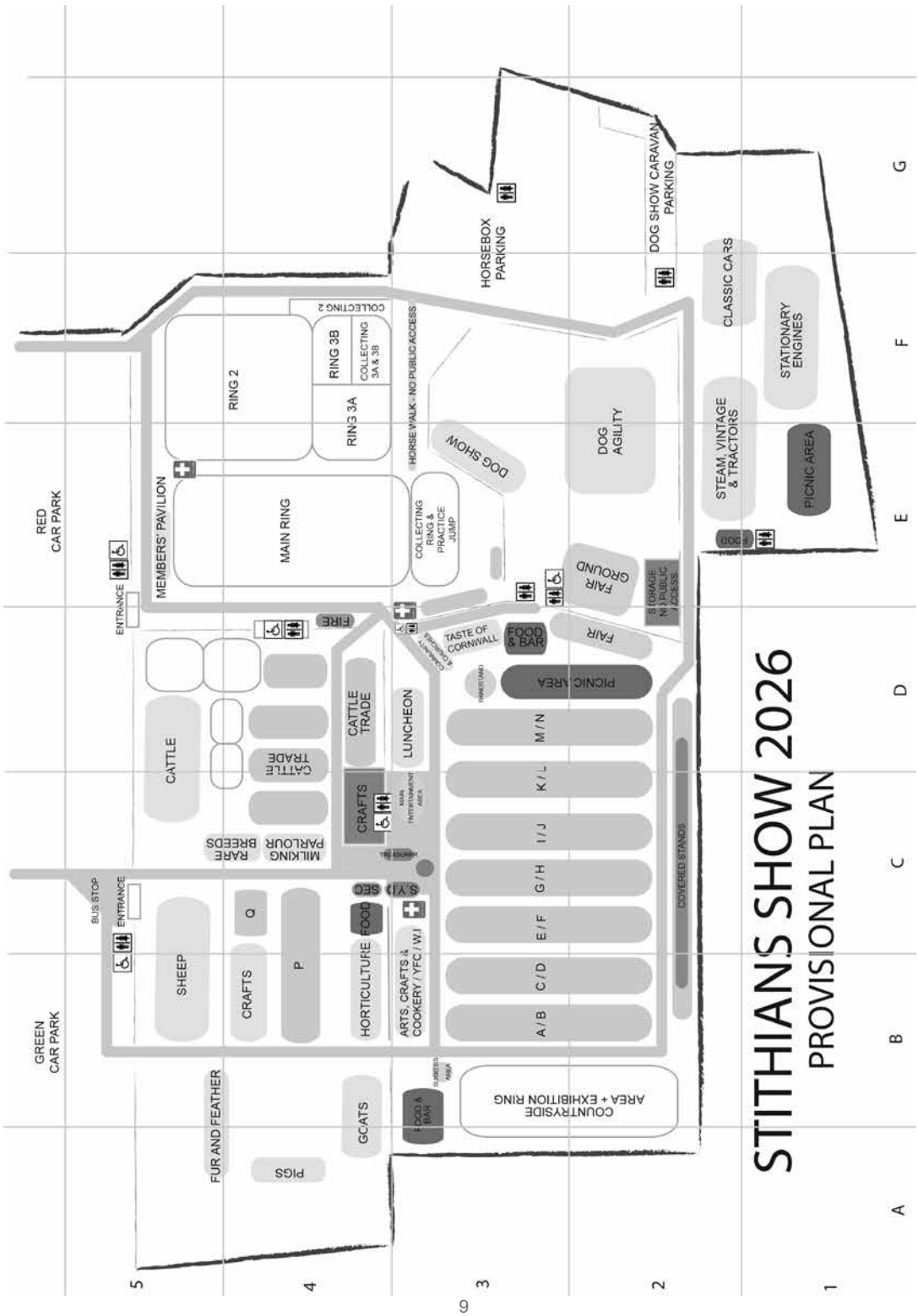

Health & Safety Policy

Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974

The Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999

GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

We commit to operating the Association in accordance with the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and all applicable legislation made under the Act 'so far as is reasonably practicable'. Our policy is to ensure that the Show is operated in a safe manner for all our employees, volunteers and the general public, and to provide such information, training and supervision as is needed for this purpose.

We also accept our responsibility for the health and safety of other people who may be affected by our activities. The Association acknowledges that the Show is likely to attract those who may be vulnerable and will consider them in their risk assessment of the event. The Association has an Event Safety Management Plan in place which covers all aspects of the operation of the Show and is available from the Show Office.

The Board of Trustees acknowledge that Health and Safety responsibilities within the Association are of equal importance as other priorities and will ensure resources are available to manage Health and Safety. Although the Board of Trustees accept responsibility for the implementation of the Plan, it relies on individual employees/volunteers to accept their own duty and responsibility to themselves, fellow workers and others who might be injured/affected by their acts or omissions. The Plan will be kept up to date, and appropriate to the Association's activities. To ensure this, the Plan will be monitored and reviewed every year or more frequently if required.

SAFETY INFORMATION AND GUIDANCE

All Exhibitors must comply with the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and all relevant legislation and guidance. Animal exhibitors must also comply with the Animal Welfare Act 2018 and any relevant codes of practice, guidance, etc. provided by the relevant governing body organisations. Further safety information is contained within the Stithians Show Health and Safety Manual which is made available to those exhibiting at the Show. All exhibitors will be expected to have read this document along with any relevant set-up and break down site rules.

SHOW SECURITY

The Association's appointed security contractor will provide 24-hour CCTV monitoring of the site from the Monday before the Show and guarded night cover between 19:00 and 07:00 from the Thursday before the Show and then 24/7 from 07:00 on the Saturday until 07:00 on the Tuesday after the Show. The Association's use of CCTV monitoring in some areas of the Showground is to enhance safety and reduce the risk of criminal activity. The location of the cameras may be moved in accordance with notified risks. The Association will not be responsible for the safe custody of any article brought for exhibition, nor will they be liable for any loss or damage that may occur to any article. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to ensure they have adequately insured their stock and equipment whilst on site and to report any suspicious behaviour to the Security Team.

FIRE SAFETY

All catering outlets and trade stands must assess the risk of fire. Where an ignition source is identified, or where hot works or cooking is carried out on the stand then suitable firefighting and prevention measures must be put in place. BBQs are not permitted on the Showground.

FIRST AID/MEDICAL COVER

If you are setting up prior to, or packing up after Show day, you are advised to ensure you have a first aid kit available. On Show day the Association's First Aid contractor will be on site. The nearest A & E Dept is at The Royal Cornwall Hospital, Triliske, Truro TR1 3LQ. Minor Injury Units are located at Camborne Redruth Community Hospital, Barncoose, Redruth, TR15 3ER and Falmouth Hospital, Trescobeeas Road, Falmouth, TR11 2JA; both of which require you to contact NHS 111 by phone or online prior to visiting. All accidents/incidents and near misses must be reported to the Show's Health and Safety Advisor who is contactable by radio or via the Show Office.

GAS SAFETY

Any fixed installation gas equipment (cookers, pipework, valves etc.) must comply with the provisions of the Gas Safety (Installation and Use) Regulations 1998. All catering vans / marquees with gas installation MUST have a Gas Safety Certificate issued by a competent Gas Safe Engineer and dated within the last 12 months. A copy of the

certificate MUST BE provided to the organisers prior to entry to the event. Crimped connection fittings must be used rather than jubilee clips. Further information can be found on the Nationwide Caterers Association website The Gas Safety Checklist - The Do's and Don'ts - NCASS"

ECOLI AND GENERAL INFECTION CONTROL

The Show provides the ideal opportunity for the public to interact with the animals. It is important that hand washing with soap and water is carried out by everyone following contact with animals and pens. There are hand washing facilities in the animal areas and in the toilet blocks on the Showground.

ELECTRICAL SUPPLY

Legislation requires electrical equipment to be maintained in good condition and for it to be suitable for the environment in which it is to be used. All portable electrical equipment brought onto the Showground must be maintained in good condition and where required, evidence of portable appliance testing be available to our Officers. The Show reserves the right to remove from use any equipment they deem to be unsafe. Further information is available from the HSE website <https://www.hse.gov.uk/pubns/books/hsg107.htm>

Diesel and LPG generators - the use of diesel and LPG generators is permitted provided modern, quiet equipment is used. Stand-alone petrol generators are not permitted. Petrol generators that are professionally built in as part of an operating unit may be used. The Association reserves the right to request any generator that is unsafe or causing a nuisance from fumes be switched off and removed.

SHOWGROUND TRAFFIC

All Showground traffic must give priority to pedestrians and riders and strictly observe speed restrictions at times when such movement is permitted. There is a one-way system in place during build up and break down - please adhere to this. The speed limit on site is **10mph**.

During the Show (08:00 to 18:00) all Showground roadways must be kept clear of any obstruction to allow unimpeded access by emergency vehicles. **There is no unauthorised vehicle movement permitted between the hours of 08:30 and 18:00.**

Livestock exhibitors: may leave the Showground prior to 18:00, subject to the approval of a Showyard Director and notification to the Section Secretary (movement is to enable compliance with Animal Welfare Regulations). The Livestock dispersal will be strictly controlled. Livestock exhibitors must park in the areas allocated to them and be respectful of others when parking.

WASTE

Traders and Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that any waste is removed from site and their area is left in a clean and tidy state.

OPENING HOURS

Trade and Craft Stand Exhibitors are required to remain open until 18:00 and **MUST NOT** attempt to leave the Showground before that time. Those found to be packing up early and attempting to leave the Showground may find that their application is refused for future Shows.

VIOLENCE AND AGGRESSION

Physical or verbal violence or aggression towards our Show Team, Contractors or Officials will not be tolerated; you will be asked to leave the Showground without any recompense. If you have a complaint, we can usually deal with any issues if approached in a civil manner but cannot guarantee to always resolve issues on the day of the Show.

MAJOR INCIDENT PLANNING (SITE EVACUATION)

In the event of a major incident where it is necessary to evacuate the site or part of the site, please follow all signs and instructions from the organisers and Emergency Services. ALL people will be requested to evacuate the site, until it is deemed safe to return. The Association accepts no responsibility for any property or livestock or any person or persons who fail to comply with the request to evacuate the Showground.

Animal Escape - Animals are unpredictable and do occasionally break free. Please get yourself and others under your control to safety in a quiet and calm manner and allow those involved in the recapture to do this unimpeded.

WEATHER

It would be extremely unusual for us to cancel the event due to adverse weather. We have, however in the past had to delay set up due to high winds. Please ensure that your contact details are up to date when applying for a trade stand or exhibitors' space. In such circumstances we will communicate with you by email and social media.

It is your responsibility to ensure that you have appropriate structures for your stand. Garden-type gazebos are not suitable for use on the Showground and we encourage you to use a purpose-built shelter available from reputable suppliers. Please ensure that you have adequate anchorage and weights for your structure.

PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE

Whilst the Association has its own Public Liability cover in place it is only for its own protection. All exhibitors must have their own Public Liability insurance which covers them for attendance at the Stithians Show."
