



The Sower's Academy: Homeschool Instructional Program Financial Agreement for 2026-2027 School Year

New Family Application fee: No charge to apply

New Enrollment Fee: For new families offered enrollment, a one-time **non-refundable \$300 enrollment fee per student** is required to complete enrollment and must be paid in full before new enrollment is complete.

Continuous Enrollment Fee: Current families may pay their continuous enrollment fee by March 31 to secure continuous enrollment for the next academic year. The Continuous Enrollment Fee is non-refundable and \$300 per FAMILY. If a student withdraws for the upcoming year after March 1, the fee will remain non-refundable.

Payment Terms:

All tuition payments and enrollment fees are non-refundable. Quarterly tuition payments are due on the 20th of August, November, February and April. Notice of withdrawal MUST be made in writing 30 days prior to intended withdrawal date. If a student withdraws between August 1st-Dec. 19th, parent is responsible for full payment of Quarter 1 and Quarter 2 tuition. If a student withdraws between December 20th- May 8th, parent is responsible for Quarter 3 and Quarter 4 tuition payments. Families will have the option to re-enroll for the following year by March 1st and will pay a non-refundable continuous enrollment fee of \$300 per family to secure enrollment for the new academic year. If a student is dismissed or asked to withdraw by the Sower's Academy, parents are not responsible for completing remaining tuition payments, however, all previously paid tuition and fees are non-refundable.

Parent Program Participation Requirements

Active Church Attendance/Membership: Parents and students must maintain active church membership and attend in-person services regularly at an evangelical (Protestant) Christian church that would agree with and uphold Sower's Statement of Faith. Church membership will be verified with pastoral staff each academic year.

Homeschool Learning Days: One parent must be available to homeschool their child at least one additional day per week to complete assigned program lessons. Required lessons will be provided weekly by teacher and all students are expected to complete assigned lessons at home in preparation for program meeting days.

Student Academic Progress and Standardized Testing: As a homeschool instructional program (non-private school), all parents are fully responsible for the educational progress of their homeschool student. Parents utilizing a PEP scholarship are responsible for issuing student an annual standardized assessment. A copy of the most recent student assessment must be submitted to the Sower's Academy for new admission or continuing enrollment consideration.

Grade Placement and Instructional Fit: TSA may consider placement adjustments of up to one grade level above or below a student's chronological grade on a case-by-case basis, based on academic skill level and developmental readiness. All placement decisions are made at the discretion of the instructional program. Students are expected to maintain pace with their assigned skill-level group with consistent parental support at home. TSA reserves the right to determine continued enrollment in a grade placement if a student is unable to sustain expected academic progress or if required at-home support and interventions are not consistently implemented.

Step Up for Students Scholarships: TSA is an approved Service Provider in EMA through the Step Up for Students scholarship program for use with FTCPEP and FES-UA scholarship funds under the Service Offerings Category of "Home Education Tuition/Fees." Families who receive a scholarship have the option to pay for tuition in four (4) quarterly payments from their EMA account. **If a scholarship award has not been distributed by tuition payment deadlines, parents are responsible to pay tuition out-of-pocket on a month to month basis and seek reimbursement. TSA is not responsible for guaranteeing any tuition or program-associated fee reimbursements.*
