Driver•i Device LED Indicators

Left LED Status	Right LED Status	Description
Blinking RED	OFF	Driver•i device is booting up. If the device stays in this state for over 60 seconds, please contact support.
GREEN	GREEN	Privacy mode is OFF. Inward camera is ON and recording.
GREEN	RED	Privacy mode is ON. Inward camera is OFF and not recording.
GREEN	PURPLE*	Enhanced Privacy mode ON. Inward camera recording OFF. Inward camera-based alerts will be generated, No inward video is saved.
GREEN	Blinking BLUE	Driver•i in Bluetooth pairing mode for Installer App connection.
Any color	Off for over 30 seconds	Driver•i in error state. Please contact support.

^{*}By default, the Right LED is set to PURPLE in Enhanced Privacy mode. However, in Enhanced and Custom Privacy Modes, customers can set the Right LED color to either RED, GREEN, or PURPLE through IDMS

Note: If driver-facing camera is disabled, Right LED will always be RED. The Privacy Mode is activated only if the conditions mentioned in the "Privacy Mode" section are met. The Camera is ready to record after the 25 seconds boot-up time. After ignition key/vehicle is OFF, camera recording is based on "Recording Options" set by the Safety Manager.

NO LED*	DMS not connected to Driver-i or DMS connected in (LPM) Low Power Mode.
	DMS needs to be paired and calibrated.

Privacy Mode

Privacy Mode: Enabled automatically when the vehicle speed is 0MPH / KPH for 3 to 4 minutes. In this case, Left LED is GREEN, and Right LED turns from GREEN to RED.

Note: Driver•i works in units of "minutes", so if the vehicle became stationary in the 1st seconds of "minutes", the device may take up to 3 min 59 sec of idling before privacy mode is enabled.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why does recognizing positive driving matter?

How do I "tag" a video alert for my manager?

To capture a Driver Initiated Alert, press the Driver Alert Button. The Driver Alert Button is located at the bottom of the Driver•i devices (for the D-810 model, this button is on the wired speaker). When a Driver Initiated Alert it captured, a 1-minute video alert will be created on the Driver•i dashboard.

The outward facing camera feed can be helpful in capturing some of the following scenarios:

- · Road-rage by another driver
- Exoneration of a false claim or traffic violation
- Hit-and-run collisions

What is the purpose of this program?

The purpose of the Driver•i program is to improve driver safety through identifying coachable opportunities and reducing collisions. The program takes a holistic view of driving habits, recognizing and rewarding good behavior while highlighting areas for improvement.

Who can view the video?

Only users with authorized credentials have access to the secure Driver•i portal.
