Hi, I'm Eddie!

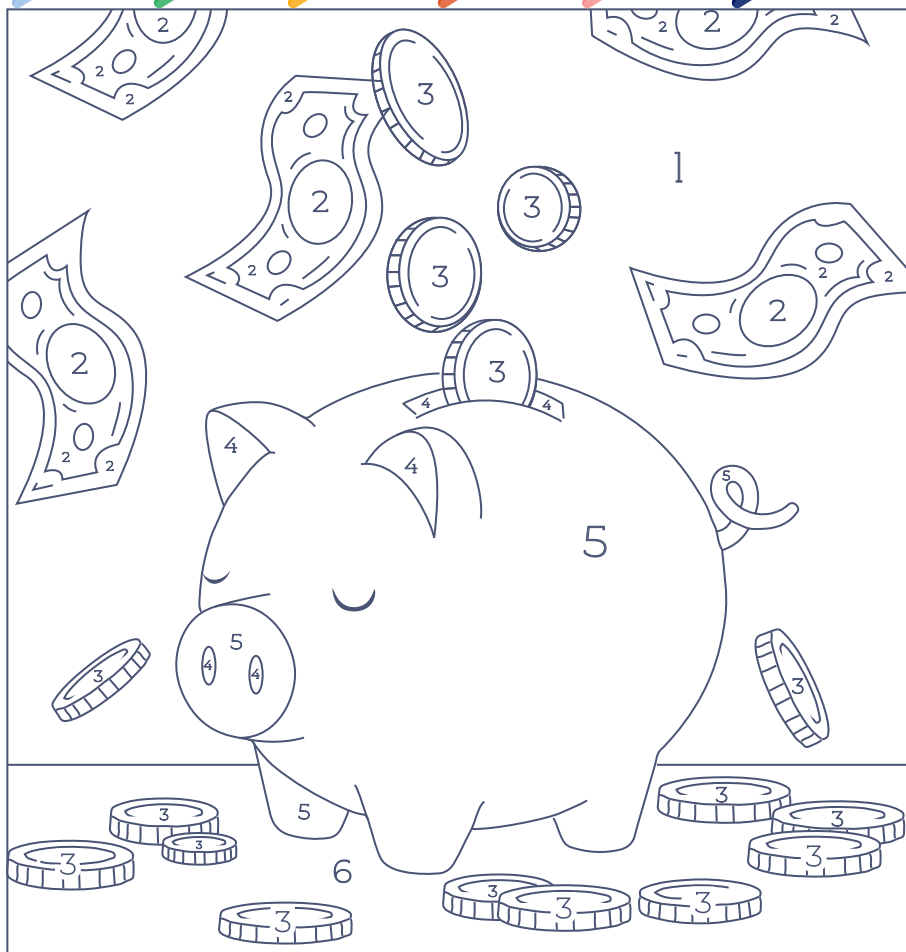
I love learning new things at school and at home. My mom is a teacher, but I think I'm her favorite student.

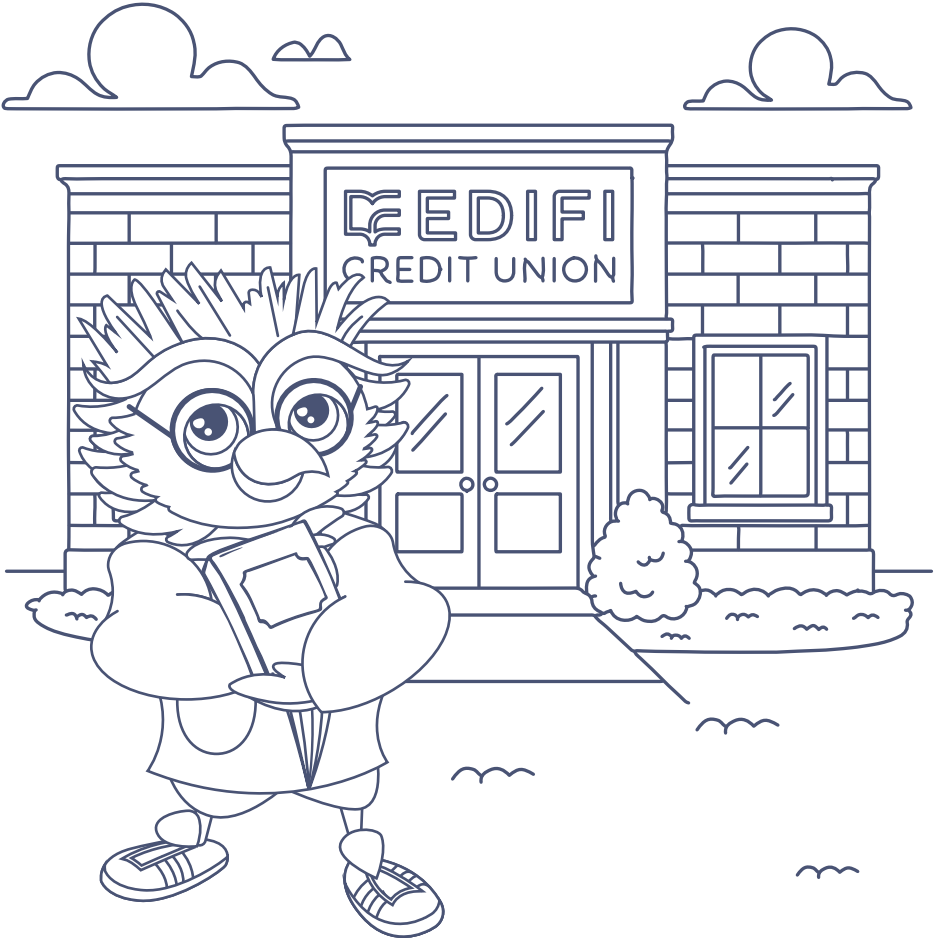
