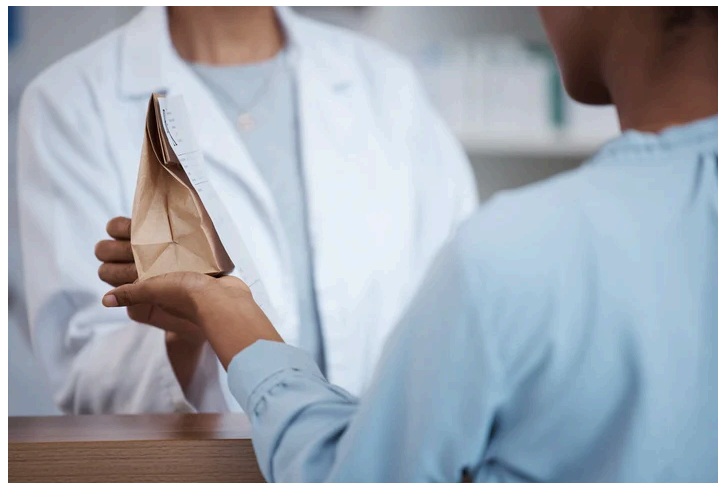

Study Finds PA Denials Are Stalling Care

A recent study of Medicare Part D claims (2020–2024)¹ found that over half of these claims are denied on the first submission (70%+ in most chronic categories), and take 14–24 days on average for approval (10–19% wait 5+ weeks), and typically

face two to three rejections before getting a green light. When approval never comes, up to 80% of patients never start therapy.
