Your Infusion Treatment: What to Expect

1 Before Your Appointment

Scheduling & Prep: A OnePulse Connect Nurse will schedule your infusion and give you any special instructions.

Insurance & Consent: You may be asked to review insurance coverage and sign consent forms.

What to Bring: A list of current medications, a book or headphones, and something cozy—infusions can take time.

3 Getting Started

Medication Review: Your Nurse will confirm medications and other key information with you.

Comfort Check: You'll be seated in a comfortable chair with blankets, snacks, and entertainment options available.

2 Arrival & Check-In

Welcome: You'll check in at the front desk and be guided to the infusion area.

Vitals & Assessment: A OnePulse Connect Nurse will check your vitals and ask how you're feeling.

4 During the Infusion

Monitoring: Your Nurse will monitor you for side effects and check in regularly.

Relaxation Time: You can read, nap, watch a show, or just relax.



5 After the Infusion

Observation: You may be asked to stay briefly for monitoring.

Discharge Instructions: You'll receive guidance on what to expect at home.

6 Follow-Up

Next Steps: Your Nurse will schedule your next infusion or follow-up appointment.
